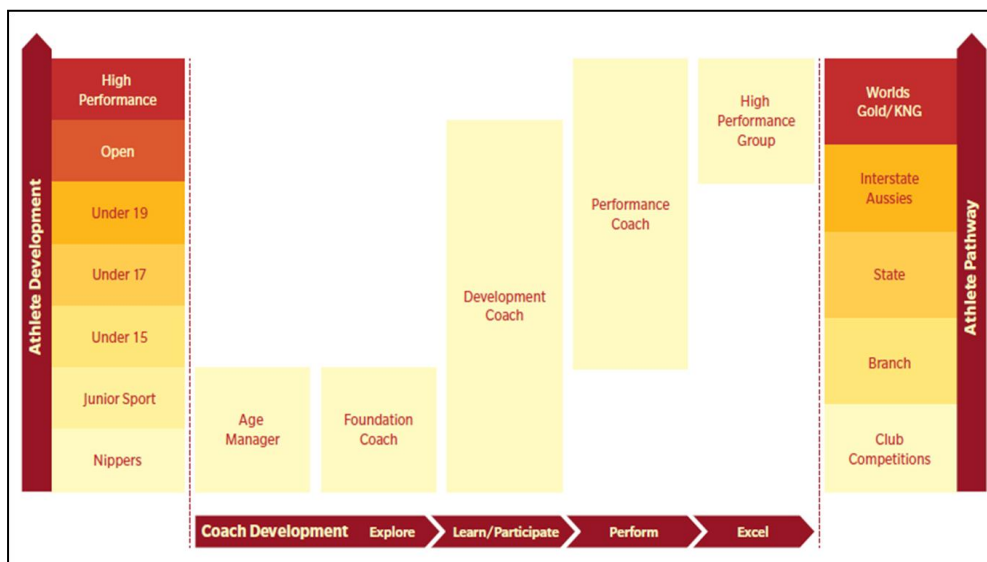

Following a comprehensive review of the SLSA Surf Sports Coaching Framework in 2012/13, SLSA has redesigned the way coaches are recruited, trained, supported, and retained. The result is a contemporary, flexible, interactive and purpose-built coach development framework, designed to ensure we are developing **great coaches** in all coaching environments and in all Surf Sport disciplines.

The new SLSA Coaching Framework is fundamentally taking over what was formally known as the Junior Coaching, Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 courses. The major change to the coaching framework is that it is now discipline specific. SLSA Surf Sports Coach training sits under the umbrella of the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS), which covers over 80 different sports throughout Australia and is managed by the Australian Sports Commission (ASC). SLSA has a 5-tiered Coaching Pathway which is outlined in Figure 1 below.  
*Note: The Age Manager qualification is not part of the National Coach Accreditation Scheme.*



The new coaching course format has two components; theory and practical. The theoretical component is all done online in your own time prior to the practical session. All the theoretical components must be completed prior to the practical session.

Surf Life Saving New South Wales is pleased to announce that nominations are now open for coaches wishing to gain accreditation in the new Foundation & Development Coaching Courses.

The practical workshop date and location will be communicated with all nominees when secured with each branch. In the meantime, the theoretical components can be started and completed ready for when the practical workshop details are confirmed.

### Cost

Foundation: \$175 including GST

Development: \$230 including GST

Following the close of nominations, you will receive information on the course and payment methods.

### How to Nominate

2. All nominees must be current financial members of a SLSC.
3. Ensure you have a [Members Portal](#) Account
4. Write down your Members Portal username; you will need this information when completing the nomination survey.

6. Following the close of nominations, you will be contacted and given information on your nominated course, payment methods and access to Pulse (SLSA's Online Learning Portal) where you will complete the online modules relevant to the coaching course you have chosen.
7. SLSNSW will contact you when your branch secures a date and location for the practical workshop. You cannot participate in the practical workshop if you have not completed all theory components.
