Athletes and Team Management members that are successful in gaining selection will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- [Team Management Online Nominations](#) closes at 11pm Sunday 5 July 2015.
- [Athlete Online Nominations](#) close 11pm Saturday 18 July 2015.
- It is anticipated that all successful athletes will be notified the week following the close of nominations. Please note that SLSNSW reserves the right to make adjustments to composition and team numbers as per the [Selection Policy](#). All nominees must be current financial members, proficient with their relevant awards, and be endorsed by both club and branch representatives prior to nomination.

All successful athletes and team management members will be required to complete both the [ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping](#) and [Match Fixing](#) e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.01 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Mikaela Mew mmew@surflifesaving.com.au. SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations. If anyone has previously completed either course, proof must be sent through to Mikaela in order to be recognised.
