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Summary	Full funded patrolling equipment options available for SLSNSW Clubs and Branches
Objective	To provide an opportunity for Clubs/Branches (with proven needs) to gain access to additional funding for operational lifesaving equipment.
Action	Clubs to complete applications and return to Branch Offices by Friday 15th April 2016 Branch Offices to prioritize all applications and forward priority lists to the SLSNSW Office by 29th April 2016 SLSNSW to notify all applicants and Branches of application statuses and approved equipment funding. SLSNSW to bulk purchase all approved equipment direct from identified equipment distributors on behalf of all successful grant recipients.

2015-16 Lifesaving Equipment Grant (LEG)

The Lifesaving Equipment Grant is once again available through SLSNSW to Clubs and Branches. This grant is proudly supported by the NSW Government, to assist clubs purchasing new equipment to ensure Lifesaving rescue equipment is an acceptable standard throughout the state.

Improved Grant Process

Surf Life Saving NSW has streamlined the Lifesaving Equipment Grant process to reduce workload and increase value to Clubs. The process improvements also provide effective acquittal and documentation of the Grant.

Clubs will continue to submit applications to Branches utilizing a selected "Equipment List" consisting of essential frontline patrolling equipment; Branches will prioritise Club applications; and SLSNSW bulk purchases all approved equipment on behalf of the successful grant applicants, reducing administrative demands on Clubs and Branches.

Eligible Equipment

SLSNSW has identified a list of essential patrolling equipment for eligible for funding through the 2015-16 Lifesaving Equipment Grant. The attached application form identifies the "Eligible Equipment List" and provides Clubs with the opportunity to prioritise and identify the individual equipment requirements of each Club.

Note: Only equipment items identified on the "Eligible Equipment List" will be approved for funding by SLSNSW.

Full and Partial Funding Options

Due to the bulk purchasing focus of the 2016 Lifesaving Equipment Grant, full funded items is the preferred funding option, however; partial funding exceptions may be granted for more expensive items such as All-Terrain Vehicles, IRB's and RWC's. Please contact the NSW Lifesaving Officer to discuss partial funding options where required.

2016 Lifesaving Equipment Grant – APPLICATION FORM

Grant Application Process

The following steps indicate the requirements and due dates to apply for the 2015-16 Lifesaving Equipment Grant.

Step 1: Clubs Submit Applications

Clubs to submit application to Branches for equipment from the Lifesaving Equipment Grant “Equipment List” with information and/ or documents supporting their application.

Clubs to submit applications before: **Friday 15th April 2016**

Step 2: Branch Prioritisations

Branches to prioritise Club applications according to Branch funding pools and submit to SLSNSW by DATE.

Branches to submit prioritisation lists to SLSNSW before: **Friday 29th April 2016**

Step 3: SLSNSW Approval

SLSNSW to notify all applicants and Branches of application statuses and funding approvals.

SLSNSW to release approval notifications by: **Friday 13th May 2016**

Step 4: Equipment Purchasing

SLSNSW will bulk purchase all approved equipment on behalf of all successful applicants.

All Equipment will be paid for by SLSNSW upon completion of application approvals

Step 5: Equipment Distribution

SLSNSW will provide all delivery and contact details to equipment suppliers that were supplied in applications.

Equipment deliveries are estimated from: **June to September 2016**
