The competition will take place at the Sir Owen G Glenn National Aquatic Centre at AUT Millennium

Team Management Touring Levy:

A levy of approximately \$900 (incl. GST) will be payable for all team management to assist with the cost of travel, accommodation, food, team activities, insurance etc. Clubs will be invoiced the levy amount and it will be up to the club to pass on this expense to the individual. The final levy amount will be determined in the near future once the tour logistics and planning have been finalised.

- All nominees must have an Australian passport with at least 6 months validity.

E-Learning:

All successful team management members will be required to complete both the [ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping](#) and [Match Fixing](#) e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.01 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Tim Piper tpiper@surflifesaving.com.au. SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations. If anyone has previously completed either course, proof must be sent through to Tim in order to be recognised.
