These Surf Boat Sweep Schools are part of the SLSNSW Development Pathway and are run by NSW's most experienced sweeps and are designed to improve the skill level of all sweeps and surf boat rowers regardless of their current level of experience.

The objective of these schools is to increase the skill level of surf boat competition at carnivals and increase the participation of Surf Boat competitors throughout NSW.

The 2016 SLSNSW Surf Boat Sweep School Program will have theory and practical components including various presentations on relevant surf boat topics with an open forum theme encouraging discussions and questions. Some of the topics that the Surf Boat Sweep Schools will cover will include;

- Introduction to surfboats
- Basic sweeping techniques
- Waves and the ocean
- Safety in surfboats
- Racing in a surfboat
- Skills to prepare for a race and many more!

- All nominees must be current financial members, proficient with their relevant awards, and be endorsed by their club to attend. All attendees must be 16 years of age or older. This information will be crosschecked on Surfguard.
- Please familiarise yourself with section 5.1, in particular clause (f) and (g) of the Surf Sports Manual. The wearing of helmets in surf conditions is fully supported and recommended by SLSNSW. This can be found on the [SLSA Members Portal](#) at Library>Sport>Manuals & Technical Rules>SLSA>Surf Sports Manual>SSM Section 5.
- The cost for each participant to attend the Sweep School will be \$20 – your club will be invoiced. More information will be given to each participant following the close of nominations on the logistics and payment details.
- While it is not compulsory to hold a boat coach accreditation and boat sweep accreditation to sweep *outside* of competition, you must have these accreditations in order to sweep *in* competition. There will be accredited coaches and accredited sweeps at all sweep schools to ensure the trainings are carried out safely and correctly.

- Following the sweep school, and provided you have competed and received your coaching accreditation, you can complete the Boat Sweep Accreditation Checklist. You cannot sweep in competition without these awards.

Please note: A minimum of 10 participants must register for the school to go ahead. SLSNSW will advise participants prior to the course if this quota is not reached. Tea, coffee will be provided, however accommodation and travel will be the responsibility of the individual.
