Re:	Scrutineering - 2016 Country & NSW State Championships

At the 2016 Country and NSW State Championships only random scrutineering of craft and equipment will take place.

It is a requirement that all competitors **MUST** have their craft scrutineered through their Branches prior to the 2016 Country and State Championships.

In exceptional circumstances if scrutineering is to take place for competitors at the above events; it will be at a cost of \$110.00 (incl. GST) per craft/equipment and a black and white scrutineering sticker will be placed on the craft. There will also be significant delays in having the equipment scrutineered.

A fee will not be charged in the following situations:

COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Craft purchased or won after **18th January 2016**, as long as a receipt (proof of purchase) is sighted by the scrutineers.
- Craft damaged after **18th January 2016** that requires repairs where the scrutineering sticker is placed. A receipt or letter from repairer is to be sighted by the scrutineers

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Craft purchased or won after 18th February 2016, as long as a receipt (proof of purchase) is sighted by the scrutineers.
- Craft damaged after 18th February 2016 that requires repairs where the scrutineering sticker is placed. A receipt or letter from repairer is to be sighted by the scrutineers.

Clubs are advised to refer to their Branch as to when scrutineering will be conducted.
