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<b>Subject:</b>	<b>Restricted Entry Events – 2016 NSW Age Championships</b>

At the 2016 NSW State Age Championships the Ironperson and the Board Rescue are now restricted entry events.

This change is to enable efficient and effective timetabling of these events from heats to finals with regards to surf/weather conditions.

Competitors must now qualify through Branch, with the number of entries allocated as per table below:
