Subject:	Grant Opportunity – Keep Australia Beautiful Beverage Container Recycling Community Grants 2016 (Closing 1 July 2016)

The **Keep Australia Beautiful Beverage Container Recycling Community Grants 2016** is now open.

The program provides funding assistance to local community projects that demonstrate a measurable result in diverting beverage containers out of landfill, through increased recycling at a local level.

Funding of **up to \$20,000** (inc GST) is available for projects that:

- address the specific issue of beverage container recycling and its by-products
- practical local solutions that can be used as examples for others and leave a legacy
- do not duplicate existing recycling activities
- result in measurable volumes of recycled materials

Preference will be given to projects that:

- Demonstrate a thorough understanding of the litter and recycling problem in their community and have identified evidence-based solutions;
- Have identified clear project objectives and a solid methodology to evaluate the success of their project;
- Provide an accurate project budget with all resources identified including sources of additional funding if applicable;
- Demonstrate a plan to instigate community behaviour change, not simply installing waste management infrastructure;
- Have proven a community-wide benefit;
- Demonstrate a plan to engage a wide and diverse group of stakeholders in project delivery;
- Prove that their project can continue after the initial support from the grant.

Examples of the types of projects funded include:

- Recycling education projects
- Assistance with transporting or processing containers to overcome remote location or dispersed population
- Infrastructure for events or venues eg. Recycling Bins (fixed & mobile), Recycling signage, Bottle Crushers

Please note:

- Results will be notified by August 2016 and projects must be implemented by February 2017
- Quotes are required to be submitted with the application
- Recipients will be required to adhere to various media, branding and signage conditions – please refer to Grants Terms and Conditions for full details
