## **1. Update:**

As per previous notifications Round 4 will be conducted on Saturday 13 June with the Round 2 Carry Over being held on Sunday 14 June from event #30 through to finals.

## **2. Scrutineering:**

**All equipment that was not registered and scrutineered ( excluding PFDs and Helmets) at Caves Beach prior to Round 1, must be presented to the head scrutineer with the appropriate forms before it enters the competition area at Kiama Downs.**

**Failure to comply with this request is not in the spirit of competition and will result in the club facing disciplinary action**

**State IRB Championships** will require all IRB equipment (including IRB patient helmets) to be presented for scrutineering. All equipment used at these Championships must be owned by the Club.

## **3. Parking and Gear Trailers:**

Please follow the direction of the Club Officials. Trailer parking is designated on the reserve to the south of the SLSC. A fence has been constructed along the Western side of concrete path to form a barrier between pedestrians and cars driving on reserve.

No heavy vehicles are to park on the reserve.

Vehicles can be parked in the car park opposite the Surf Club.

## **4. Beach Access:**

IRB access will be via the Surf Club at 150 North Kiama Drive, Kiama Downs NSW 2533.

Club officials will be directing traffic and towing IRBs onto the beach and to the competition area. No persons shall sit in the IRB while it is being towed.

No private vehicles will be permitted on the beach.

## **5. Event Schedule:**

\*\* Premiership Presentations will start approx. 1.5 hours after last race concluded on Sunday.

## **7. Team Managers Meeting:**

The Team Managers meeting will be held at the Administration Tent

- Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 June @ **0735**

2 representatives per Club will be permitted to attend.

\*NOTE: This meeting is compulsory.

In the event of further Team Managers meetings being called during competition, it is asked that only Team Managers attend these meetings to ensure correct communication of information.

Any team substitutions may be submitted at the Team Managers meeting to the Referee Steward Wendy Walsh.

## **8. Competition Area:**

The competition area will be made up of 1 water area.

Clubs are asked to follow instructions given by event staff and club work crew when setting up club tents.

See Event Map for details on proposed competition area set-up.

## **9. Security:**

There will not be any security on site for the duration of the event including the overnight period from Friday to Saturday. Clubs are urged to take all gear and equipment with them after competition on Saturday afternoon. SLSNSW and Kiama Downs SLSC accept no responsibility for and loss, theft or damage to equipment.

Any person/s found stealing signage or any equipment owned by SLSNSW or its sponsors will immediately be brought before a Carnival Disciplinary Committee or a SLSNSW Judiciary Meeting for possible further action.

Please note that automatic disqualification of the team/club from the Championship will occur if any member is found guilty of theft.

## **10. Photography & Media:**

SLSNSW will not be issuing any media/photography accreditation to Team members or Team Management.

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a club shall make media statements which could bring the IRB Premiership, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements shall be deemed to be a breach of SLSA discipline and will be dealt with accordingly. Statements to the media about the Series will be made only by approved SLSNSW personnel.

## 11. Personal Protective Equipment:

Refer to [SLSA Bulletin 12/14-15: IRB Lifejacket and High Visibility Vest Changes](#)

*“In all training and competition it is compulsory for drivers, crew persons and patients to wear SLSA approved level 50 Lifejackets (level 50S Lifejackets unless listed on the SLSA Approved Gear and Equipment List are not permitted). It is not required for high visibility safety vests to be worn over the top of Lifejackets. See also Section 2 of the Surf Sports Manual”*

SLSNSW will not be issuing personal protective equipment garments as part of the event entry fee – this is the responsibility of the individual/club.

As it states in the below link, ALL patients must wear an appropriate helmet \*. Random safety checks on these helmets will take place throughout the event:

\*Helmets are not required to be worn by patients in training or competition for the IRB Rescue Tube Race only.





To assist with judging, SLSNSW has replaced coloured lane vests with long sleeve coloured rash shirts.

Long sleeve coloured lane rash shirts must be worn under the lifejacket. This will apply to the IRB Driver only.

## Personal Protective Equipment



- All certified level 50 Australian Standard (AS4758) life jackets are approved for IRB competitions, these must be in high visibility (conspicuous) colour
- **Note.** Level 50S are not permitted
