Subject:	Grant Opportunity – Stockland Community Grant Program 2016

The **Stockland Community Grant Program 2016** is now open. The program aims to provide one-off funding for not-for-profit organisations in recognition of their contribution to their local community.

Funding of **\$1,000** is available for projects that support local health, leisure and recreation clubs or programs, local employment, education and skills development initiatives, social engagement clubs and programs and environmental programs. Applications must be for initiatives which **will be implemented in the Local Government Area of a participating Stockland asset** – please refer to the below list for further details.

Applications must be for a project which demonstrates alignment with one of the following focus areas relevant to SLS:

- **Health & Wellbeing** – initiatives which enable communities to participate in active living practises, eg. exercise, sport and recreational programs
- **Education** – initiatives which enable the development of personal wellbeing and prosperity for individuals, families and communities
- **Connection** – initiatives which engage community groups to activate community infrastructure through programs and events centred on inclusion for all ages and abilities

Key points:

- It is important your application clearly states which Stockland community members will benefit from the program/activity you are proposing
- Applications can be submitted online only - no email confirmation or copy of your application is provided once submitted therefore we suggest you draft your application in a word document first for saving/filing once completed
- Proposed initiatives must be able to be undertaken within 6 months of the grant being awarded
