- Funding of **up to \$4,000** help kids in local community through art, music, sport, sustainability, or social well-being.
- Whites Rural is focused on funding remote or rural areas that will have a collective impact for young people in the community.
- Safety Equipment and sporting equipment are suitable items to apply for.
- There are 10 grants in total
 - 2 grants in NSW/ACT
 - 2 grants in QLD
 - 2 grants in VIC/TAS
 - 2 grants in SA/NT
 - 2 grants in WA
- Submissions can be in writing (700 word max) or by video (1 min max). Open to Australian residents from regional, rural, and remote areas.
