Summary:	SLSA are seeking responses to a survey on the new changes introduced into the Skills Maintenance process this season.

### Skills Maintenance Feedback

Following a national review of the Skills Maintenance process prior to last season, a number of changes were introduced this season as a trial, including:

- skills maintenance theory tools (online and paper-based) to give members more options
- a workcard to assist in tracking skills maintenance activities
- scenarios to use during quiet times on patrol to maintain skills during the season
- a new delegated authority option to assist with the burden on assessors
- an interstate deployment policy to enhance consistency across state borders
- bulk processing in SurfGuard to reduce admin time
