Title:	Surf Sport: Aussies 2019 – Call for Officials Nominations

Summary:	SLSA is calling for all Technical Officials, Lifesaving Officials and Support Services Roles at the Australian National Lifesaving Championships 2019.

SLSA is calling for nominations from ALL Surf Sports Officials, as well as all Medical Personnel wishing to participate at the 2019 Australian Youth Life Saving Championships, Australian Masters Life Saving Championship and The Australian Open Life Saving Championships to be held across the North Burleigh, Broadbeach and Burleigh Beaches in Queensland from Saturday 30th March to Sunday 7th April 2019.

For Aussies 2019, SLSA will be making **ONE** call for official nominations (unless roles are not fulfilled) for The Australian National Lifesaving Championships (The Championships), this will include all technical officials, lifesaving officials and support services roles.

NOMINATIONS OPEN

As the events will be conducted over a number of areas, SLSA is looking for adequately experienced officials to fill positions in each of the section/areas. Nominations should include details of preferred roles you would like to fulfil at the event, with three (3) preferences listed in priority order.

If you have nominated for a Senior Officials position at either of the 3 Championships (per Circular 12/18-19), please ensure you nominate for a Technical Officials position should you be unsuccessful in gaining the Senior role.

The appointment of all Officials will be made jointly by the Championship Referee and the National Officials Advisor. Officials will be finalised as soon as possible after the close of nomination and all appointments will be posted on the members area and SLS website. Late nominating Officials will be added to the 'Officials Pool' and duties and appointments made subject to availability of roles. All officials should ensure they are physically capable to carry out their important functions over the course of the Championships, and are encouraged to undertake a medical check prior to departure to the Championships.

NOTE: In planning for The Championships, appointed Technical Officials may be required to attend a meeting to appointment the Technical Officials for your respective area.

NOTE: All appointed Officials will be required to complete the online **OFFICIALS BRIEFING** as well as attend the briefing in their appointed competition areas, prior to competition. All times and location will be outlined in the Officials Appointment Circular distributed at a later date. As part of The Championships safety procedures, the safety and contingency plans will be communicated in detail. Therefore, the Officials online briefing is mandatory and failure to complete may result in your appointment being terminated and or referred to the Australian Championships Competition and Safety & Emergency Committee for further action.
