The purpose of this memo is to inform Country Clubs, Country Branch Presidents, Country Branch Secretaries & CEO's, and Country Directors of Surf Sports that due to insufficient officials numbers the 2019 Envirobank Country Championships could potentially result in a dramatically reduced event format.

Officials nominations opened back in October 2018 and due to the small amount of nominations received a 2<sup>nd</sup> call was released in December and closed on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2019.

As it currently stands, we are still well below the required number of officials to successfully run the 2019 Envirobank Country Championships and will extend the 2<sup>nd</sup> call until **11pm Monday 7 January 2019**.

If the number of official nominations has not significantly increased by **Monday** SLSNSW will consider the potential reduction in events.
