Subject:	Grant Opportunity - Australian Sports Commission Local Sporting Champions Program (closing 31 October 2017)

Round 2 of the 2017/18 **Australian Sports Commission (ASC) Local Sporting Champions Program** is open. The program is designed to provide financial assistance for young people aged 12-18 years participating in **state, national and international level sporting championships** as either an athlete, coach, umpire or referee.

Funding of **\$500** for individual applicants is available, to contribute to the cost of **travel, accommodation, uniforms or equipment** required for participation in the nominated championships.

Key points to consider when applying include:

- Applicants must be turning 12 to 18 years of age in the same calendar year as the nominated sporting championship.
- Applicants must be an Australian citizen or have been granted permanent resident status, residing in Australia or by a School Sport Australia member body.
- The championship event must be endorsed by the relevant ASC recognised national sporting organisation.
- Applicants must be living more than 125km from the championship venue, and travelling greater than 250km (return) to participate in the nominated championship.
- Applicants must not have received more than \$500 in federal funding for the event, or be participating in an event that involves prize money greater than \$500.
- Applicants must not have received a Local Sporting Champions grant for an application submitted in the same allocation year (1 March – 28/29 February).

There are 36 individual grants available in each metropolitan electorate and 50 individual grants available in non-metropolitan (provincial or rural) electorates per allocation year (1 March to 28/29 February). For information on whether your electorate is a metropolitan or non-metropolitan please visit the Australian Electoral Commission website <http://apps.aec.gov.au/esearch/>. You may also wish to make contact with your electorate office to discuss your application and seek their support.

Applicants should apply once you have been selected to attend the championships and your participation has been confirmed. It is essential that you submit your application prior to the event. Applicants are assessed at the conclusion of each round therefore it may be up to four months before you are notified. It is therefore important that you forward plan your application to ensure you receive notification and/or funding prior to your event, or in many cases, you may not receive notification until after your attendance at the championships, in which case the grant will be a reimbursement of costs incurred.
