Subject:	Memo: Foundation for National Parks and Wildlife (FNPW) Bushfire Restoration Grants (ongoing until 31/12 or expended)

The **Foundation for National Parks and Wildlife Bushfire Restoration Grants** are now opening, ongoing until **31/12/21**. This program seeks to support tree planting projects as part of bushfire restoration and revegetation projects in and around regions impacted by the 2019-20 Black Summer bushfires.

Key points:

- Up to \$5,000 for projects in LGAs classified as affected by the 2019-20 bushfires that are carried out over a 6 to 12 month period. To see which LGAs are classified as bushfire affected, you can use the map available at www.bushfirerecovery.gov.au/your-community/local-area-profiles#/map.
- Priority will be given to:
 - projects and organisations that undertake work in or around national parks or state managed conservation areas;
 - are planting trees sourced from an FNPW bushfire recovery partner nursery;
 - demonstrate a co-contribution in cash and/or in kind.
- Required information and attachments include but are not limited to:
 - Quotes
 - Project risk assessment including in relation to COVID-19
 - Evidence of consent or support from landholder and/or traditional owner groups (if required)
 - Any other documents that support your application, e.g. letters of support from other community organisations

Applications under this program are **ongoing until 31/12/21 unless expended first**. Applications are expected to be assessed monthly. Further details can be accessed from <https://fnpw.org.au/grant/bushfire-restoration-grants/>.
