Participate in policy reviews, or creation of new policies on sport integrity related subjects</li> <li>3. Attend and participate in national sport workshops (twice annually)</li> <li>4. Attend and participate in sport management meetings (needs basis)</li> <li>5. Proactively bring matters of sport integrity to the attention of the SLSA Sport Manager</li> <li>6. Represent SLSA in forums / conferences relating to sport integrity</li> </ol>
