## Program Overview

Do you see yourself taking on a leadership role within Surf Life Saving? Are you interested in shaping the future leadership culture of our organisation? We are looking for 48 active surf lifesavers across NSW to join us for a jam-packed weekend of fun and self-development, taking part in a first-of-its-kind leadership program designed to deliver real impact throughout Surf Life Saving NSW!

## What's it all about?

This is the development program to explore what leadership means for SLSNSW! The high-paced program will be partially facilitated by leadership professionals to ensure participants get the most out of the weekend. The program will combine short, sharp education sessions with future-focused workshopping sessions to build participants' knowledge, skills and confidence, whilst also engaging them to reflect upon what the organisation needs from its leaders in the future.

The outcome of this program will inform a roadmap for skilled, effective and passionate leaders into the future. This roadmap will be presented for discussion at the SLSNSW Board Meeting in February 2020. It will help us to deliver on our strategic plan as we strive to work better together by enabling a strong leadership culture to lead the organisation now and future proof our capability moving forward.

## Who can apply?

Active surf lifesavers who are newly appointed position holders, or who see themselves taking on a leadership role in the next three years. We are looking for proactive surf lifesavers who are keen to have a say in the future of our organisation, develop their leadership skills, have fun, be inclusive, work hard, champion change and be the voice of the future!
