ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

On behalf of the Club Team, the Team COVID Marshal is responsible for the following at a SLSNSW event;

- Each Club is required to nominate a COVID Marshal for each event bio-zone at the 2021 NSW State Championships;
 - U9 – U11 Water Championships at Swansea Belmont (25th and 26th February)*
 - U9 – U11 Beach Championships at Redhead (25th and 26th February)*
 - U12 – U14 Water Championships at Swansea Belmont (27th and 28th February)*
 - U12 – U14 Beach Championships at Redhead (27th and 28th February)*
 - Open Championships – Water at Swansea Belmont (5th – 7th March)*
 - Open Championships – Beach at Redhead (6th March)*
 - Masters Championships at Swansea Belmont (13th and 14th March)*
 - Lifesaving Championships as part of the Masters Championships at Swansea Belmont (12th – 14th March)*
 - Surf Boat Championships*
- Always wear a fluorescent COVID Marshal vest for the duration of your COVID Marshal appointment
- Inform your team of the COVID requirements in place for the State Championship Events
- Educate and remind your team of social distancing and hygiene regulations in place for the Event
- The Club tent is one of the key risk areas identified by SLSNSW in relation to social distancing. The COVID marshal is responsible for reducing this risk under Club tents during the Championships by reminding members to remain 1.5m apart and demonstrating good person hygiene
- Act as the COVID contact point for your team during the Event; and,
- Report any breaches or non-compliance to the Safety & Emergency Manager or SLSNSW Biosecurity Safety Coordinator.
