Dear Volunteers

Thank you for your contribution to the safety of the NSW Surf Life Saving Championships proudly supported by Your local club.

The following information is a brief Q&A regarding your first aid shift.

Where do I meet?

Please sign in at the first aid room at the Lifeguard Shed just south of Swansea Belmont SLSC. You will be met here by one of our first aid services staff and given a full briefing on operations.

What area will I be covering?

You will be allocated an area however the first aid services staff will do their best to try and allocate you to an area where you desire.

Do we need to bring first aid gear?

No - all first aid gear will be provided.

What do I wear?

You will be provided with a first aid vest/shirt for your shift. This vest must be returned at the end of your shift. What you wear can be flexible but we would recommend patrol shorts, shirt, hat, sunglasses and sunscreen.

Where do I park?

Unfortunately due to the limited amount of available parking, first aid volunteers are required to park in the same areas as competitors e.g. backstreets.

Meals?

If you are rostered on for the morning shift you will be provided with morning tea and if you are rostered on the afternoon shift you will be provided with lunch. Water will also be supplied.
