Authorised By:	Chair, Sport
Purpose:	To represent the views of Surf Life Saving members and provide advice and recommendations on specific projects to the Chair, Sport.
Reports To:	Chair, Sport
Roles:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contribute to the development, review of, and reporting against the SLS 2020 Visions and the SLSA Business Plan, particularly in those matters pertaining to lifesaving sport • Provide insights and recommendations to the Chair, Sport relating to any current or future strategic interventions that may impact on lifesaving sport
Authorities and Limitations:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can make recommendations to the Chair, Sport for his consideration and advocacy to the SLSA president and the SLSA CEO on matter related to Lifesaving Sport • Its deliberations and recommendations are confidential
Composition:	The working groups shall be comprised of skill based members for the specific project that is being deliberated
Responsibilities of SPBWG Representatives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accurately represent the prevailing views of their members fully and accurately to the best of their ability • To maintain commitment to the values of the Surf Life Saving movement through all deliberations • To judge each issue on its merit with particular reference of benefits to the movement and the public
Quorum:	The quorum for any working groups shall be at least three (3) members entitled to provide a recommendation.
Meeting Schedule:	As required by the specific project
Provision of Recommendations:	All listed members shall be entitled to contribute to any recommendation. The Chair, Sport shall have the right to determine the final recommendation where a consensus cannot be reached.
