Summary:	Outlines the requirements and procedures to enter the 2018 NSW Midford Board Riding Championships.

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1. INTRODUCTION:

The 2018 NSW Midford Board Riding Championships will once again see the State's best board riders represent their respective Surf Life Saving clubs at one of the most iconic surfing locations in Australia. Similar to the 2017 event no pre-qualification is required via the Branch.

The SLSNSW Board Riding Championships will be held from Friday 7 September to Sunday 9 September 2018 at North Narrabeen SLSC in the Sydney Northern Beaches Branch.

2. 2018 NSW MIDFORD BOARD RIDING CHAMPIONSHIPS COMPETITION COMMITTEE:

The 2018 NSW Midford Board Riding Championships Competition Committee (CC) will direct all matters relating to the actual conduct of the competition. The CC may, subject to the rules in the Surf Sports Manual (35th edition) and event rules, any subsequent amending bulletins and this Circular, postpone, cancel and/or alter any or all Championship events, and alter the venue of the competition.

A review of the following will be conducted at each CC meeting:

- a. Risk Assessment of the current conditions of the beach, environmental risks and back of beach area
- b. Injury management statistics
- c. Current weather predictions
- d. Competition statistics

The CC may consult and seek advice from appropriate officials, athletes and other personnel on local weather, surf conditions and safety issues when required. The CC may appoint the various sub committees and panels as required for the Championships.

The CC are responsible for enacting the contingency plan for the Championships. The Safety Operations Manual developed for this event is to be applied by the Championship Referee when considering and making recommendations, in consultation with relevant emergency services and lifesaving authorities.

3. ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE:

All entrants must meet SLSNSW award, patrol and proficiency requirements as per the 2017/18 proficiency competition requirements and any other subsequent bulletins issued (Policy 5.4).

As the competition season is 2017/18, the age group of the competitor is the same as they have been in for the entire season e.g. Branch, Country or State Championships.

4. QUALIFICATION PROCESS:

The SLSNSW Board Riding Championships has seen the qualification process removed from the event thus meaning competitors no longer require to qualify through their Branch. The waitlist and wildcard entry process has also been removed.

6. DOUBLE DIPPING:

Double dipping is permitted in certain age groups as per Section 2.3.4 of the SSM. Masters competitors can only compete in one master's age division but can compete in the Opens category.

7. JUDGING CRITERIA:

8. BOARD RIDING CRAFT CRITERIA:

As per Surf Australia Competition the longboard specifications are:

- The board length is a minimum of 9 feet measured from the nose to the tail on the deck of the surfboard.
- The width dimensions are to be a total minimum 51 inches in aggregate this is the total of the widest point, plus the width 12 inches up from the tail and 12 inches back from the nose.
- The shape of the long board is to be traditional and may include multiple fins and channels, but cannot include add on tail or nose blocks.

9. ENTRIES - CARNIVAL MANAGER:

Please ensure your Club notes the following points in addition to the Carnival Manager Guide before and during the entry process:

- Before you start your club entries, ensure you action a 'forced SurfGuard update' to make sure all club athlete information in Carnival Manager is up-to-date.
- Usernames and passwords have been issued to clubs. If you require these please contact SLSNSW.
- Competitors must be entered into Carnival Manager by their Club by Sunday 26 August.

10. ENTRY FEES:

The entry fee per competitor at the 2016 NSW Board Riding Championships is **<u>\$38.50</u>** (incl. GST).

Please note; Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in these Championships or if the event is cancelled.

Clubs will be directly invoiced for entries.

Tag Team Event:

Due to the success at the Aussies Board Riding Championships a Tag Team event may be trialed on the Sunday morning of competition (if time allows). This will be a non-championship event. The event will be an 8 team competition (2 Semi Finals of 4 teams, followed by a Final of 4 teams). The configuration of the team will be any Male or Female Shortboard surfers from U13 to Masters. Preferably teams will be made up from the same Club however composite teams will also be permitted within a Branch. In saying this Club teams will still be given preference over composite teams. Each team shall consist of five members. However, we may change this to four if there are not 8 clubs that can fill a team of five.

12. DAY OF COMPETITION:

This event will be staged at North Narrabeen SLSC. The specific location will be advised in the final event memo with contingency locations identified. Competitors will be communicated via SMS if any changes are to occur (regarding location, start time etc.). 13. MEDIA AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

Photography:

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have photos and video taken during the Board Riding Championships used for promotional material by SLSNSW. SLSNSW will not be issuing media/photography accreditation to team members or team management. Professional photographers will be attending and material will be available via social media and to Clubs on request. Club Team Management are welcome to take photographs from outside the competition area. Go Pro's may only be used within the competition area on approved fittings and fixtures as set out in relevant SLSA bulletins.

Media:

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a club shall make media statements which could bring the Championships, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements will be a breach of policy and could potentially result in sanctions against members involved. Please note that statements to the media regarding about the Championships will be made only by approved authorised spokespeople.

Drones:

For the safety of competitors, officials and spectators SLSNSW prohibits the use of drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) at these Championships by members and/or public unless approved by SLSNSW, 7 days prior to the event. The operator must supply an operations manual (including risk management plan), provide a copy of public liability insurance and comply with all Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) requirements.

14. BEHAVIOUR/MISCONDUCT:

Misconduct before, during and after the Championships will not be tolerated. Offending members risk disciplinary action against themselves and their Clubs.

Parents or supporters deeming to be assisting competitors during the competition either stationary on the beach or in the water near the competition area will result in immediate disqualification from the competition (at the discretion of the carnival referee).
