Message from Referee

For clarity, Event Referee David Unger has specified the following regarding entry conditions:

- a) Individual Events Competitors only to complete in their own age as per last Surf Season 2017/18. U11 to U15 cannot go up at all i.e U11 only in U11, U12 only in U12 etc. to U15. U17 up as the Surf Sports Manual.
- b) Team Events Competitors only in their own age as per last Surf Season 2017/18, U11 to U15. U11 to be U11, U12 &U13 to be either a U12 or U13, U14 & U15 to be either U14 or U15. U17 up as the Surf Sports Manual.
- c) Line Throw Competitors are only allowed in their own age as per last surf season 2017/18. U11 to U15 cannot go up at all. i.e U11 only in U11, U12 only in U12 etc. to U15. U17 up as the Surf Sports Manual.

Competitors **will** be required to pay an admission fee of **\$5.00** per day. All others including Team Managers, Parents and Spectators **will be** required to pay a one off admission fee of **\$5.00** per person per day.

Officials **will not** be required to pay an admission fee. The centre administration will be given a list of Officials for both Saturday and Sunday. Officials will need to sign off their names at reception.

To assist with seating space it is asked that competitors be mindful of the amount of bags being brought into the seating arena.

Warm Up / Competition

Please note: ATHLETES MUST STAY AWAY FROM THE ELECTRONIC TOUCH PADS DURING WARM UP.

If you plan on warming up please make sure your Club adheres to the below designated lanes.

Only athletes contesting upcoming events and officials will be permitted in and around the pool deck. The pool deck on the south side of the pool is off limits to competitors and spectators (See Appendix A).

Athletes and Team Managers are asked to remain in the grandstand area unless being marshalled for an event.

Team Managers Meeting

The Team Managers meetings will be held

- o Saturday 14 July 0730
- Sunday 15 July 0815

1 representative per Club will be permitted to attend. The location of the team managers meeting will be communicated by the announcer on the day.

*NOTE: This meeting is compulsory.

In the event of further Team Managers meetings being called during competition, it is asked that only Team Managers attend these meetings to ensure correct communication of information.

Volunteer Quota (Pool Setters & Time Keepers)

While Officials have been appointed to coordinate the event, a shift ratio (pool setters and timekeepers) has been developed based on the number of participants per club from the number of entries. This is required to ensure the efficient running of this Championship event and SLSNSW appreciates your involvement.

Please note these volunteers will not receive event catering (morning tea or lunch). Only appointed accredited officials will receive catering.

Time keepers will not be required to bring their own stop watches as these will be supplied by SLSNSW.

Heats / Lane Draws

Heat/Lane draws will be available on the day for the competition and provided to Team Managers at the Team Managers Meeting.

Due to the number of NT (no time entries) and the transfer of the meet file to the Electronic Timing Pad Computer system, bugs and errors are created and can affect the random draws.

Team Managers are asked to check the event start lists and record any changes or scratchings via the 'Team Changes Notification Advice' In an effort to minimise the number of people in the administration room - Team Managers are asked to submit changes on the forms supplied and can also be accessed from the following link:

Entry Changes

Should competitors wish to withdraw from a race, please advise the Referee Steward as soon as practical. As advised in the Entry Circular, additional events are \$19.90 incl GST and there are no late entries.

Entry Payment

SLSNSW will issue an invoice to the club based on the entries in Meet Manager the week after the Championships.

Presentation

The Presentation will occur at the western side of the pool deck (inside). Presentations will occur 'in blocks' after events have been run. Please listen to announcements.

Note: SLSNSW will not be posting out any unclaimed medals; it is the responsibility of Clubs to collect medals from presentation throughout the day. Do not wait until the end of the day to collect your medals.

Catering

The Woy Woy Peninsula Leisure Centre have a kiosk inside the centre.

Officials Only

A light breakfast, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea will be provided. Water will also be provided.

It is encouraged that officials have breakfast prior/ provide their own breakfast for the event, as SLSNSW will only provide a light breakfast.

Meet Manager Mobile



This event will be accessible via the Meet Manager Mobile app on IOS and Android. Team Management and supporters are encouraged to download the app via iTunes or the Play Store prior to the Championships.

On Saturday, once Meet Mobile has been activated, you will be able to find the meet by searching "SLSNSW 2018 Pool Rescue Championships" within the app. SLSNSW makes no guarantees that results or reports this app will be up to date or correct and it is only provided for reference only.

Please follow the advice of officials and referees (via announcements) regarding all aspects of competition and do not rely solely on the app.

Example of App

Photography & Media

SLSNSW will not be issuing any media/photography accreditation to Team members or Team Management.

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a club shall make media statements which could bring the 2018 NSW Pool Rescue Championship, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements shall be deemed to be a breach of SLSA discipline and will be dealt with accordingly. Statements to the media about the Series will be made only by approved SLSNSW personnel.

Equipment

SLSNSW will only be supplying the below equipment:

- Pool manikins
- Pool tubes
- Pool line throw ropes
- Pool bricks

Pointscore

As per the entry circular an interclub point score will be conducted based on the results of individual and team events for 1st through to 6th placing (or less if the actual number of competitors is less than 6) for the Championships.

All events will be of equal points and the club with the highest aggregate of points at the conclusion of the competition shall be declared the winners in each division (Youth, Open, Masters).

Please note there is no Overall Club Point score.
