The Team Management appointments are valid for the 2019 & 2020 seasons (2 year) and will be selected based on previous experience and awards.

The roles available for the NSW Interstate Team are:

- Team Manager (x1) 2 year appointment
- Assistant Team Manager (x1) 2 year appointment

Requirements of Team Management:

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but not limited to:

- Provide logistical support, and attend all development/high performance clinics and team training
- Team Management will be required to submit a written report within 3 weeks of the completion of the carnival.
- Proficient and Financial SLSC member, endorsed by club & branch
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules, in particular to the NSW State Team
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate and Working With Children Check (WWCC)
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate in enhancing the success of the NSW Surf Boat Interstate Team

How to Nominate:

1) Read and familiarise yourself with the <u>Selection Policy</u> and the <u>SLSNSW Athlete & Management</u> <u>Agreement</u>. Successful applicants will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.

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- 2) All nominees must be current financial members, proficient with their relevant awards, and be endorsed by both club and branch representatives prior to nomination. Endorsement letters must be provided upon submission of online nomination.
- 3) Complete the Online Nomination Form by 11pm Sunday 11 November 2018.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2020 Surf Boat Interstate Championships.

Cost:

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals.

In the event of an athlete levy being introduced, Team Management will be liable for 50% of the confirmed amount.

E-Learning:

All successful team management members will be required to complete both the <u>ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping</u> and <u>Match Fixing</u> e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.01 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Chiara Nowland cnowland@surflifesaving.com.au

SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations. If anyone has previously completed either course, proof must be sent through to Chiara in order to be recognised.
