SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Team Management roles to assist the 2019 NSW IRB Interstate Team in competing at the 2019 IRB Interstate Championships to be held at Cudgen Headland SLSC on Friday 12 July 2019.

### The roles available for the NSW Interstate Team are:

- Lead Coach (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Assistant Coach (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Team Manager (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Assistant Team Manager (x1) – 2 year appointment

### Requirements of Team Management:

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but not limited to:

- SLSNSW strongly encourages both male and female management to nominate, both genders will be represented in management travelling with the Interstate Team
- Lead and Assistant Coaches to have completed a Development Coach – IRB Award
- Financial SLSC member, endorsed by club & branch
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Attend all team training sessions
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of NSW Athletes
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing competition (Team Manager)
- Assist with organising various training sessions and development programs for NSW IRB teams within the appointment period

### How to Nominate:

1. Read the SLSA IRB Interstate Rules and Entry Circular (when available)
2. All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW [Selection Policy](#) and the SLSNSW [Athlete & Management Agreement](#). All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
3. Complete the [Online Nomination Form](#) by **11pm Sunday 9 December 2018**.
4. All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire letters of endorsement – Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2020 IRB Interstate Championships.

### Team Levy:

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals. Selected Team Management may already be attending the Australian IRB Championships with their club teams.

If an athlete levy is introduced, Interstate Team Management will be liable for 50% of the confirmed amount.

### E-Learning:

All successful athletes and team management members will be required to complete both the ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping and Match Fixing e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.1 1 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Chiara Nowland [cnowland@surflifesaving.com.au](mailto:cnowland@surflifesaving.com.au). SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations.
