SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Team Management roles to assist the NSW Pool Rescue Interstate Team in competing at the 2019 SLSA Pool Rescue Interstate Championships to be held at the Gold Coast Aquatic Centre, QLD on Friday 9 August. 2020 Venue and Dates TBC.

The roles available for the NSW Pool Rescue Interstate Team are:

- Lead Coach (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Assistant Coach (x1) – 2 year appointment
- Team Manager (x1) – 2 year appointment

Second year appointment subject to review by SLSNSW Director of Surf Sports and SLSNSW Sports Officer

Requirements of Team Management:

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but not limited to:

- SLSNSW strongly encourages both male and female management to nominate, both genders will be represented in management travelling with the Interstate Team
- Assist with organising various State Team Training Sessions and Development Clinics for Pool Rescue within the appointment period
- Lead and Assistant Coaches to have completed a Development Coach – Pool Rescue Award
- Attend all team training sessions
- Assist with the facilitation of SLSNSW Pool Rescue Development Clinics (coaches)
- Financial SLSC member, endorsed by Club & Branch
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of NSW Athletes
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing competition (Team Manager)

How to Nominate:

1. Read the SLSA Pool Rescue Interstate Rules and Entry Circular (when available)
2. All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW [Selection Policy](#) and the SLSNSW [Athlete & Management Agreement](#). All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
3. Complete the [Online Nomination Form](#) by **11pm Sunday 31 March 2019**.
4. All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire letters of endorsement – Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2020 Pool Rescue Interstate Championships.

Team Levy:

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals. Selected Team Management may already be attending the Australian Pool Rescue Championships with their club teams.

E-Learning:

All successful Team Management are encouraged to complete both the ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping and Match Fixing e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.1 1 & 5.02).

Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Chiara Nowland cnowland@surflifesaving.com.au. SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations.
