Subject:	Scholarship Opportunity – Future 500 Leaders Governance Scholarship (closing 3 May 2019)

The Institute of Community Directors Australia is offering up to 500 governance scholarships towards the Diploma of Business (Governance). This round is focusing on scholarships for women.

- This scholarship includes
 - A \$1,000 fee reduction for enrolments in the Diploma of Business (Governance) (BSB50715 delivered by Federation Training). This means that the reduced enrolment cost for scholarship recipients is \$3,495 (inc GST)
 - An iPad pre-loaded with course materials
 - Membership of the Institute of Community Directors Australia
 - Access to the Institute of Community Directors Australia's extensive suite of online governance resources
- Successful applicants who complete their Diploma of Business (Governance) will also earn Australia's only accredited qualification for not-for-profit governance and Fellowship of the Institute of Community Directors Australia

Key points to consider when applying include:

- Applications will be assessed against the following criteria: passion for community; suitability for completing the Diploma; and reasons for wanting to improve their governance skills.
- Applicants must be able to
 - attend and actively participate in a total of five days of training (three consecutive days plus two consecutive days approximately one month later) - courses offered across Australia
 - commit to completing all assessments within 12 months of beginning of face-to-face training (expected time commitment is five to 10 hours for each of the 12 units)
 - commit to transferring the knowledge you have gained through this course to the not-for-profit sector

Please note that this is an individual application; not an application that is completed on behalf of a club.
