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# 1. INTRODUCTION

The 2020 Envirobank NSW Country Championships attracts Country Branch competitors from the Under 8's to Masters, providing opportunity to unite over a two day period showcasing one of Australia's most iconic volunteer movements, Surf Life Saving.

This year's event will be held at Cudgen Headland SLSC, in Tweed Shire Council from Saturday 1 February to Sunday 2 February 2020.

This document outlines some key information relating to the 2020 SLSNSW Envirobank Country Surf Life Saving Championships. Please note that SLSNSW may issue subsequent bulletins, memos or circulars which may supersede information provided in this Circular.

- SLSNSW will send invoices to all Clubs after online late entries close. Do not pay until the invoice is received.
- Clubs are reminded to complete the <u>Team Manger Registration Form</u> (which is replacing the previous paper-based Declaration Form) as soon as possible. This Team Manager Registration Form includes Clubs logging their team manager contact details. This is to ensure all event communications such as changes to timetables, re-locations etc. can be sent via SMS and Email. Details about the Team Managers meeting format will be available soon.
- Clubs are reminded to complete the online <u>Powercraft Form</u> to input Powercraft personnel by **Sunday 12 January at 11.00pm**.
- Note: Clubs are reminded to check all entries prior to the close of late entries on Monday 27 January for any omissions and errors.

# 5. 2020 COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS SAFETY & EMERGENCY COMMITTEE

The 2020 Country Championships Safety & Emergency Committee (CCSEC) will direct all matters relating to the safety of the competition.

A review of the following will be conducted at each CCSEC meeting:

- a) Risk Assessment of the current conditions of the beach, environmental risks and back of beach area
- b) Injury management statistics
- c) Current weather conditions & predictions
- d) Competition statistics

e) any safety issues that may cause injury to athletes, officials & the viewing public

The CCSEC may consult and seek advice from appropriate officials, athletes and other personnel on local weather, surf conditions and safety issues when required.

The CCSEC is responsible for enacting the contingency plan for this event after advising the CCCC. The Safety Operations Manual developed for this event is to be applied by the Carnival Referee, CCSEC and other Senior Officials when considering and making recommendations, in consultation with relevant emergency services and lifesaving authorities.

# 6. VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

# **Officials:**

There will be a quota system for clubs to provide accredited officials based upon the number of competitors entered. Officials, as a minimum requirement, must have a current Junior Officiating / Core Official accreditation.

Competitors Entered	Officials Required
0 to 4	0 Officials
5 to 8	1 Official
9 to 15	2 Official
16 to 25	3 Officials
26 to 35	4 Officials
36 to 50	5 Officials
51 to 65	6 Officials
66+ Competitors	7 Officials

If sufficient officials are not provided according to the above quotas SLSNSW reserves the right to impose a monetary penalty or request the offending club to show cause why that club should or should not compete at the Championships.

Clubs are reminded before entering their competitors into the entry system that they meet the quota. Please note that quotas are based on the number of competitors entered into the Championships, not the number of starters.

# Powercraft:

To ensure the safety of all competitors competing in the Championships, a Powercraft roster has been implemented. Clubs have been identified based on the average number of entries from the 2019 Championships.

Powercraft Drivers/Operators and crewpersons <u>must</u> fulfil the following requirements.

- ✓ **IRB Driver:** Be a current financial SLS member and be a proficient Silver Medallion IRB Driver.
- ✓ **IRB Crewperson:** Be a current financial SLS member, be a proficient IRB Crew Certificate.
- ✓ **RWC Operator:** Be a current financial SLS member and hold a proficient RWC Operator Certificate.
- ✓ **Both IRB and RWC**: Be experienced in ALL levels of surf conditions and competent to deal in all surf conditions.

Clubs will be required to nominate volunteer names and contact information for IRB Drivers and Crew personnel via the <u>Powercraft Form</u> by **Sunday 12 January, 11.00pm**. All IRB Drivers and Crew personnel must also bring with them their current SLSNSW Powercraft licence.

Clubs that fail to meet their requirements or to attend rostered shifts at the Championships will be suspended from competition until such a time that requirements are met.

Some Clubs may also be required to bring IRB equipment to the Championships. All IRBs supplied must be registered with SLSNSW, have passed the 2019/20 Gear and Equipment Inspection process and be entered on SurfGuard.

More information regarding the 2020 Country Championships Powercraft Roster will be released at the end of October.

### Water Safety:

All clubs are required to provide a minimum of 2 water safety personnel per day on a roster system. SLSNSW will release the water safety roster prior to the Country Championships (after late entries close). Water safety personnel will need to supply their own orange rash vest, cap, fins, rescue tube and/or Rescue Board. All water safety personnel must have a minimum current proficient SRC.

# 7. ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

All entrants must meet SLSNSW award, patrol and proficiency requirements as per the 2019/20 proficiency competition requirements and any other subsequent bulletins issued - <u>Member Resources</u>

#### Age:

No competitor will be eligible to enter into the Championships if they have not successfully completed their Junior Activities Competition Skills Evaluation and achieved the Surf Education Award appropriate to their age group. Awards must be entered into SurfGuard by 31 December 2019. If a competitor has successfully completed the necessary awards prior to this cut-off date, you must ensure that the club has entered this award in SurfGuard.

#### **Opens & Masters:**

Reference is made to the following documents which apply to this event:

- SLSA Policy 5.04 Eligibility to compete in SLSA competition
- SLSA Guidelines for Competition Eligibility
- SLSA Policy 1.02 Use of SLSA Equipment

The Proficiency requalification must be completed by close of "normal" entries to be eligible to participate in a SLS Championship or other event i.e. late entries will not be accepted for members who have not completed their proficiency requalification by the normal close of entries.

Late proficiency exemptions are required to be endorsed by both Club and Branch (on letterhead) before being received by SLSNSW. This can be sent to <u>surfsports@surlifesaving.com.au</u> and will be forwarded to the State Director of Lifesaving for consideration. Any late proficiency exemptions should be received no later than **Sunday 12 January 2020**.

# 8. ENTRY REGISTRATIONS

Club entries to the 2020 Country Championships must be submitted electronically directly into the entry registration web site address: <u>https://sportnsw.carnival.sls.com.au/eventmgr/sport/113</u>

Online entries will close at 11pm on Sunday 19 January 2020.

Note: Entries are restricted to Clubs from the Country Branches of NSW only. No Interstate or metropolitan branch competitors can enter the Carnival.

# 9. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee per competitor at the 2020 SLSNSW Envirobank Country Championships is \$43.00 (incl. GST).

SLSNSW will issue invoices to all Clubs after online late entries close. Clubs must not pay their entry fees prior to the Championships. Payment terms are as stated on the invoice.

Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in these Championships, or if events or the entire Championships are cancelled.

### Late Entries:

All online late entries received after the initial closing date will incur a late fee of \$58.20 *plus* the original entry of \$43.00 (i.e.; (\$58.20 + \$43.00 = \$101.20) incl. GST).

No individual late entries will be taken at the Administration Centre – Cudgen Headland. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of SLSNSW e.g. a competitor must be a team member replacing another team member in a team already entered. It is suggested that Clubs still enter members if there is a chance that they will be competing and then withdraw their entry prior to the close of late entry.

### **Additional Events:**

When additional events are entered for competitors (individual and / or team) a fee of \$20.60 per event / per competitor will be charged. Note: **The competitor must be already entered into the Carnival.** 

Additional individual event entries must be received no later than one hour before the start of the particular event at the Carnival Administration. For team events a substitution form is required (Finals only) and is required to be handed into the Carnival Administration.

Please Note: Any changes after the closing of entries will also incur this fee.

# **10. SPONSOR RASH VESTS**

All competitors entered into the 2020 NSW Country and State Championships will be issued an official high visibility pink competition lycra vest. It is a requirement for all competitors to wear the supplied Lycra vest in competition at the 2020 NSW Country and State Championships. See SSM (12.1, d, xviii). Clubs must ensure that competitors wear the approved lycra vest in competition, no other branded vests may be worn. Competitors may be requested to wear the approved lycra vest as part of medal presentations.

Previously in team water events at large carnivals (i.e. the 2018 NSW Age Surf Life Saving and 2018 NSW Country Championships); every junior water based competitor in <u>team</u> events was required to wear a hi-visibility **pink** numbered (1, 2, 3) singlet. SLSNSW advises this no longer required for the 2020 event.

# **11. GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Championships Point Score:**

A point score will be kept for the highest overall point score (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>).

### **Results:**

In the case of a dead heat for positions 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> each competitor will receive a respective medal and the following medal allocations will apply:

- Dead heat for 1st place
  - 2 gold and 1 bronze will be awarded (no silver will be awarded)
- One competitor in 1<sup>st</sup> place, dead heat for 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  - 1 gold and 2 silver will be awarded (no bronze will be awarded)
- One competitor in 1<sup>st</sup> place, one competitor in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, **dead heat for 3<sup>rd</sup> place** 
  - 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze will be awarded
- Dead heat for 1st place and dead heat for second 2nd place
  - 2 gold and 2 bronze will be awarded (no silver will be awarded)

### Restriction of number of competing teams per club:

Please note that there is a restriction to the number of teams that can compete for certain events. Please see the list below:

### **Under 8 years**

3800 Buchanan Relay (U8-U10) – 3 teams per club

### **Special Events**

- 3673 Senior Board Rescue (U14, U13) 3 teams per club
- 3674 Junior Board Rescue (U12, U11) 3 teams per club
- 3680 Senior (U14, U13) Cameron Relay 3 teams per club
- 3681 Junior (U11, U12) Cameron Relay 3 teams per club
- 3735 All Age Beach Relay 1 team per club

# **Restriction of Masters Events:**

Masters competitors may only compete in their own age group in individual events and in only one age category in each different team event entered.

**Note:** This section does not preclude a qualified Master competitor from participating in their Masters individual Age Group and also in Open age events. A minimum of one starter is required provided that the competitor/team correctly completes the course. Where Championship events are contested all place getters shall be awarded placing medals (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>).

# Handlers:

Handlers will not be required to be entered into the carnival manager system. It is highly recommended that handlers are current financial members of a SLSNSW club. Those who handle for a competitor that are not financial members of a SLSNSW club will not be covered under the SLSNSW Insurance Policy. Handlers are required to wear a pink high visibility vest (or at the discretion of the referee; may wear a pink high visibility bib/jacket type garment).

# **Boat Sweeps:**

All Surf Boat Sweeps entered in the Country Championships are required to have completed their Development Coach – Surf Boat Award, Sweeps Accreditation Assessment Tool and have been issued with a Sweeps Accreditation Number. SLSNSW will conduct an audit of all the sweeps entered into the carnival for compliance.

# **12. SCRUTINEERING**

All craft and equipment being used at the 2020 NSW Country Championships will be required to carry a valid Scrutineering Sticker (small Red and White). Scrutineering should have been completed in Branches prior to the Championships. Random scrutineering of craft and equipment will take place throughout the duration of the carnival. Finalists may be required to have their craft scrutineered prior to racing in event finals. Scrutineering will be available for all members at a cost of \$110.00 (incl. GST) and members will experience significant delays.

To avoid paying this fee, SLSNSW encourages that all craft is scrutineered prior to the Championships through your Branch.

### 13. MEDIA AND PHOTOGRAPHY

#### Drones:

For the safety of competitors, officials and spectators SLSNSW prohibits the use of drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) at these Championships by members and/or public unless approved by SLSNSW, 7 days prior to the event. The operator must supply an operations manual (including risk management plan), provide a copy of public liability insurance and comply with all Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) requirements.

#### Photography:

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have photos and video taken during the Championships used for promotional material by SLSNSW.

SLSNSW will not be issuing media/photography accreditation to team members or Clubs. Professional photographers will be attending, and material will be available via social media and to Clubs on request. Clubs are welcome to take photographs from outside the competition area.

Go Pro's may only be used within the competition area on approved fittings and fixtures as set out in relevant SLSA bulletins.

#### **Event Hashtag:**

The official hashtag for the event is #COUNTRYChamps20

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a club shall make media statements which could bring the Country Championships, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements will be a breach of policy and could potentially result in sanctions against members involved. Please note that statements to the media regarding the Country Championships will be made by authorized spokespeople.

# **14. HEALTH & WELLBEING**

The welfare of all competitors is of paramount importance and athletes or their parent / guardian in the case of underage competitors should seek advice prior to the competition from a qualified professional for any health concerns if required.

Any competitor or official who suffers illness or injury prior to or at the 2020 Country Championships **MUST** seek medical clearance before resuming their normal activities which includes training and competition.

In addition, SLSNSW may, at its sole discretion, require a competitor and/or official to be assessed for physical and/or psychological fitness to participate in the competition. This ensures the safety and wellbeing of the athlete concerned and fellow competitors while also ensuring all parties and Surf Life Saving NSW are not placed at risk.

# **15. ANTI-DOPING & MATCH FIXING**

It is strongly recommended that all Team Managers complete both the ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping and Match Fixing e-learning courses. Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of antidoping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great addition to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Area > Library > Governance > SLSA > Policy 5.1 1 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to <u>surfsports@surflifesaving.com.au</u>. SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations. If anyone has previously completed either course, proof must be sent through to Surf Sports SLSNSW in order to be recognised.

# **16. BEHAVIOUR/MISCONDUCT**

Any misconduct while at the Championships will not be tolerated. This includes the days leading into competition and any official social activities following the conclusion of the Championship. Offending members risk disciplinary action against both themselves and their Clubs.

Parents or supporters are not allowed to assist competitors during the competition. Any breach of this policy may result in the disqualification of an athlete from the remainder of the competition and is at the discretion of the Referee.

Please refer to 36<sup>th</sup> (Revised) Surf Sports Manual sections 2.27 SLSA Code of Behaviour and 2.28 Abuse/Inappropriate Behaviour and the Policy 6.5 – Member Protection Policy (available online at Members Area > Library > Governance > Policy > SLSA > Policy 6.5).

# **17. PROTESTS**

All protests shall be lodged with the appropriate Liaison Officer in each Area in accordance with the procedures set down in the current edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins, and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Competition Manual and or event rules upon which the protest is based.

Protest Forms are available from the Liaison Officer. An "Appeals Fee" of \$110.00 must accompany all documentation when the Protest is officially submitted to the Appeals Committee for adjudication.
