



2020 NSW Surf Boat Interbranch Championship FINAL Event Information as at 17/01/20

This document contains important final event information for all crews taking part in the 2020 Interbranch Surf Boat Championship.

Location

The 2020 Interbranch Surf Boat Championships will be held at Queenscliff SLSC (SNB) on the 19th of January. If required, the competition area will be moved North or South along the beach.

Singlets

High visibility pink lycra vests must be worn for the event. No other colour will be accepted. Crews/Branches must supply their own vests.

Team App

Team App will be used throughout the Championship as a platform to communicate important information and timetable changes to Team Manager and Competitors.

To register for these live event updates please follow the below instructions:

- 1. Download the "Team App" application from the App Store or Google Play
- 2. Log in / Sign up to receive live event notifications
- 3. Once logged in search "2020 Surf Boat Interbranch"
- 4. Click the "Become a member of this team app" icon at the top of the screen then select the "Competitors" Group

By joining the event and turning on your mobile app notifications, you will receive an immediate text and email updates as they are posted, ensuring you never miss any important information.

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Beach Access, Parking & Boat Trailer

Boat drop off and Trailer parking will be available on the North Steyne Reserve on North Steyne Road. Car parking will be available at the Manly Lagoon Reserve (off Pittwater Road). No vehicles can remain at North Steyne Reserve after drop off. A site map available on the last page of this document.

Order of Events and Format

As with all event timetables, the schedule and start times are subject to change at the Referee's discretion.

The order of events is as follows:

- o Reserve Women
- o U23 Men
- o U23 Women
- o U19 Men
- o U19 Women
- Open Women
- Open Men
- Surf Boat Relay

Event Format

There are currently 6 branches entered in this year's championship. Subject to conditions on the day we will run 6 boat races. There will be 3 round robins for each division and no final. Points will be awarded as outlined in the Points section of this bulletin.

Alleys for the first race will be drawn prior to the event. Each team will then move up one alley for each subsequent race – thus ensuring all teams and all crews rowed in different alleys throughout the event.

The boat relay will be run as the last event of the day - and again subject to conditions will be run as a 6 boat race. Should conditions be such that it is not appropriate to run the relay in this format it may be run as 2 x heats during the day and then an A and B final at the end of the day.

The event will be conducted according to the 36th revised edition of the SLSA competition Manual.

Pointscore

The format will be 3 rounds of points score.

Points will be awarded on the normal point score 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, for each round robin race. The crew with the highest points at the end of the 3 rounds will be awarded with first place.

Team points will then be awarded 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

The boat relay is worth double points.

Dead Heats

Dead heats in finals in both team and individual events shall be declared as per 36th Edition of the SSM. Placings shall be awarded as follows: Equal first will result in no second place being awarded with the next placed competitor or

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team being awarded third place etc. In the event of a three-way dead heat for first the next placed competitor or team shall be awarded fourth place and so on.

The teams who tie will both be awarded full points for that position (e.g. if two teams tie in first place, they will both be awarded 11 points each, with 3rd place being awarded 9 points)

Overall Branch Pointscore

The Branch with the highest aggregate of points at the conclusion of the competition shall be declared the winner. Further to this when the event has concluded and if there is a tied pointscore, the Branch with the most 1st placings shall be declared the winner. Failing this, the Branch with the most 2nd placings to the last placing points awarded respectively will be taken into account to determine a winner. If, after this procedure there is no single winner, then the pointscore will be declared a tie and dual trophies will be presented.

Protests

All protests shall be lodged with the appropriate Competition Liaison Officer in accordance with the procedures set down in the SSM and any subsequent bulletins and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Competition Manual and or event rules upon which the protest is based.

Protest Forms will be readily available from the Referee Steward. An "Appeals Fee" of \$110.00 (incl GST) must accompany all protest appeals when submitted to the Appeals Committee for adjudication. If the appeal is upheld, then the Appeals Fee will be fully refunded.

Warm Up Area

Warm ups can be conducted in the competition area once the course has been set. No warm ups should be conducted prior to this and crews must stay away from the cans.

Officials

We are still short of a few officials. If your team have any traveling officials it would be greatly appreciated if they could assist. The Event Referee may be required to call upon team management or competitors to assist with some official positions throughout the competition.

Inshore Search and Rescue

For boat crews in the opens category, please **nominate 1 crew member for inshore search and rescue.** The Safety and Emergency Management Coordinator will host a **compulsory briefing** with the SAR members at **7.45am at the Administration Tent.**

Catering

Queenscliff SLSC will be operating a BBQ for the duration of the event. In addition to this coffee is available for purchase from a number of surrounding cafes within walking distance to Queenscliff SLSC.

Presentation

Approximately 30mins after the conclusion of the event, the presentation will be held upstairs at Queenscliff SLSC.

Photography & Media

Photography:

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have photos and video taken during the Championships used for promotional material by SLSNSW. SLSNSW will not be issuing media/photography accreditation to team members or

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team management. Professional photographers will be attending and material will be available via social media and to Clubs on request. Branch Team Management are welcome to take photographs from outside the competition area. Go Pro's may only be used within the competition area on approved fittings and fixtures as set out in relevant SLSA bulletins.


Media:

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a club shall make media statements which could bring the Championships, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements will be a breach of policy and could potentially result in sanctions against members involved. Please note that statements to the media regarding about the Championships will be made only by approved authorised spokespeople.

Drones:

For the safety of competitors, officials and spectators SLSNSW prohibits the use of drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) at these Championships by members and/or public unless approved by SLSNSW, 7 days prior to the event. The operator must supply an operations manual (including risk management plan), provide a copy of public liability insurance and comply with all Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) requirements.
