IRB Drivers & Crew – Masters Championships The Board considered various options for supply of water safety powercraft at the Championships. After careful consideration it has been agreed as a trial for 2020 to allow clubs rostered on for Masters Championships IRB shifts to be permitted to utilise the AESS to undertake those shifts for a fee.

The charge for the supply of IRB crews by the AESS will be \$500 per boat/shift. Clubs may continue to utilise their volunteer drivers and crew for their rostered shifts, but this option is available to assist with clubs who find difficulty in supply these volunteers mid-week.

Please note this trial is for the Masters Championship only. Clubs will still be required to supply volunteer drivers and crews for both the Junior and Open Championship weekends. Clubs will still be required to supply IRB's and engines. Clubs must advise of their requirement to utilise AESS staff for their IRB s
