Subject:	Australian Government Dept of Social Services Volunteer Grants 2019-20	

PLEASE NOTE: This year's Volunteer Grants program is SIGNIFICANTLY DIFFERENT to previous years and <u>ONLY</u> <u>ORGANISATIONS WHO RECEIVE AN INVITATION FROM THEIR MP TO APPLY CAN DO SO</u>. Please read below for full details.

While the official close date for EOIs is 21 February 2020, <u>some Federal MP's are closing the EOI process earlier</u> (from 20 January 2020 onwards) so it is important to contact your Federal MP's electorate office AS SOON AS <u>POSSIBLE</u>. If you wish to confirm which Federal Government electorate your club or Branch is located in, please visit <u>http://electorate.aec.gov.au/</u>

The Australian Government Department of Social Services Volunteer Grants 2019-20 is now open.

The objectives of Volunteer Grants are to:

- 1. help community organisations to support the efforts of Australia's volunteers
- 2. help community organisations to support the inclusion of vulnerable people through volunteering
- 3. encourage, support and increase participation in volunteering

In the 2019-20 round of Volunteer Grants, \$66,000 is available in each of Australia's 151 Federal Electorates. Grants of \$1,000 to \$5,000 will be awarded to eligible organisations invited to apply by their Federal Member of Parliament.

To be eligible, organisations MUST

- be invited to apply by your Federal Member of Parliament (MP)
- at least 40 per cent of the organisation's staff must be volunteers

Community organisations may contact their Federal MP in relation to this Grant but this does not necessarily mean organisations will be invited to apply.

- Federal MPs will invite those organisations in his/her electorate to apply on or before 21 February 2020. Thus, should you wish to contact your Federal MP in relation to this Grant, you should do so as soon as possible.
- Should you wish to contact your Federal MP in relation to this Grant, a list of all Federal MPs and their contact details can be found at <u>www.aph.gov.au/Senators_and_Members/Parliamentarian_Search_Results?q=&mem=1&par=-1&gen=0&ps=0</u>

Examples of eligible items under this grant include:

- computer and electronic equipment including but not limited to laptops, iPads/tablets, PA systems, TVs, projectors and motion sensor/camera;
- air-conditioner;
- sunshades, marquees and umbrellas;
- first aid items, including but not limited to CPR manikins, defibs, and first aid kits;
- beach wheelchair;
- indoor furniture and appliances including but not limited to desks, chairs, lockers, trolleys, chain hoist, small appliances and white goods;
- trailer (up to 2.5m x 6.1m).

Key points to note:

- Organisations which receive an invitation from their Federal MP to apply to Volunteer Grants will receive the application form on 10 March 2020.
- Successful organisations will receive funding from July 2020.

Appendix A. 2019-20 Volunteer Grants – Item Categories

Applicants are required to select the Categories that match the items you wish to buy. Each category lists examples of items that are usually bought with Volunteer Grants money. The examples are intended as a guide only to help you select the most appropriate category. If a specific item is not listed, select the category that most closely matches the item to be bought.

Volunteer Grants money can **only** be spent on eligible items.
