- Meet at Swansea Belmont SLSC for registration and welcome packs
- Ground floor of surf club, beach side, inside the courtyard (look for the purple flags)
- We will welcome all competitors and provide an update on events based on numbers and water conditions (a risk assessment will take place prior to this time)

8.00am

- Our March Past Colour Party will move to the starting area, ready to start marching at 8.15am. You can choose on the day to participate in this event or not, and we would love supporters on the sidelines to cheer our competitors on.
- The March Past will be followed by sprints, flags and then water events.
- Our group will be on the move at all times, and move as a group between events.

10.00am

- Events to conclude with medal presentation and competitor BBQ at the Surf Club



The State Champs is a busy event – some helpful points...

Parking

There is a drop off zone near the club, parking is in surrounding streets

Change rooms

Shown on the map, let us know if you need an accessible space

Photos

Feel free to take photos of your child competing in these events

Merchandise

There is a merchandise tent beside the surf club where you can purchase event items such as shirts and hats.

Water Events

Bring your pink vest (if you have one) and board if you are planning to participate. Competitors can choose how they participate in the water eg a wade, swim or a splash around the cans depending on the conditions.

Medals

Each competitor will receive a State Championship medal for competing on the day. Event placings will also be presented with a medal.

March Past Colour Party

Join us in your club clothing (whatever you feel comfortable in) and march with your fellow competitors. The event will have a live (and loud) band playing music to march to. Please keep this in mind when joining the event.

Notes

Remember to bring your water safety support crew (wearing their orange rashie, cap and rescue tube) if you are planning on joining us in the water. Any other support that you require on the day (ear defenders, sand shoes, glasses and hats) please make sure you bring them along with you.
