Subject:	2020 NSW State Championships Lycra Vest Collection – Lifesaving, Age, Masters and Open

All competitors entered in the 2020 NSW State Championships will be issued an official high visibility pink competition lycra vest. It is a requirement for all competitors to wear the supplied lycra vest in competition at the 2020 NSW State Championships. See SSM (12.1, d, xviii). For the avoidance of doubt, Clubs must ensure that competitors wear the approved lycra vest in competition, no other branded vests may be worn in competition. Competitors may be requested to wear the approved lycra vest as part of presentation.

Lycra Vest Collection

Thank you to Clubs for completing the lycra vest order form. As a friendly reminder, these pink lycra vests are mandatory for all competitors throughout the entire Championships. Please ensure all competitors retain theirs for the duration of the competition.

Please note that one nominated person from your Club will be responsible for collecting the entire order of lycra vests for all competitors. Lycra vests will not be individually distributed to competitors.

You will be able to collect for the upcoming Championships, but we request that you come back after the initial rush.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When do I receive a lycra vest?

Collection times have been stated earlier in this memo.

Can individuals pick up lycra vests?

No. Club packs have been picked and packed in Club order by Championship event.

Can I swap sizes?

SLSNSW only has a limited sizing range of spares. We do encourage Clubs to swap amongst themselves or between Clubs as there are very few extras held by SLSNSW.

Will we get the exact order of lycra vests placed?

Best endeavors have been made to provide each Club with the quantity and sizing ordered. However you may find that sizing quantities have been amended to fit with the overall order SLSNSW needed to place with the supplier much earlier than the closing date of the order form. Due to the fact that a bulk order needed to be placed with the overseas based supplier months in advance, it was an estimate based on previous entries.

Our entries have gone up/down since we completed the online order, can we adjust?

Please return surplus lycra vests that you do not need to help us allocate it to other Clubs. Likewise, if your numbers have gone up ask at the collection point. Please note, SLSNSW has checked against entries received, so it should be near enough.

The largest size you've allocated is 2XL and this won't fit some of our members, what happens?

Unfortunately, if a member cannot physically fit the lycra vests (due the 2XL vest being too small), only these members are exempt from having to wear the official lycra vest. SLSNSW reserves the right to review exemptions.

What if my Club did not submit an order by the closing date?

Your Club has been allocated a default number and sizing of lycra vests.

What if I am doing a late entry, will I still get a lycra vest?

Yes – if the late entry was completed before the close of online late entries. There are no late entries accepted at the Championships.

Can I wear a different competition singlet/lycra vest?

No. All competitors entered in the 2020 NSW State Championships will be issued an official high visibility pink competition lycra vest. It is a requirement for all competitors to wear the supplied lycra vest in competition at the 2020 NSW State Championships. See SSM (12.1, d, xviii). For the avoidance of doubt, Clubs must ensure that competitors wear the approved lycra vest in competition, no other branded vests may be worn in competition. Competitors may be requested to wear the approved lycra vest as part of presentation.

Do we need to wear the lycra vest in March Past?

No, however it is encouraged.

Do we need to wear the vest in Beach Events?

Yes for flags and 1 or 2km beach runs. However, beach sprints are allocated different colored lycra vests per lane to assist with the judging process. These are to be returned to the officials at the end of each race.
