Complaint Management

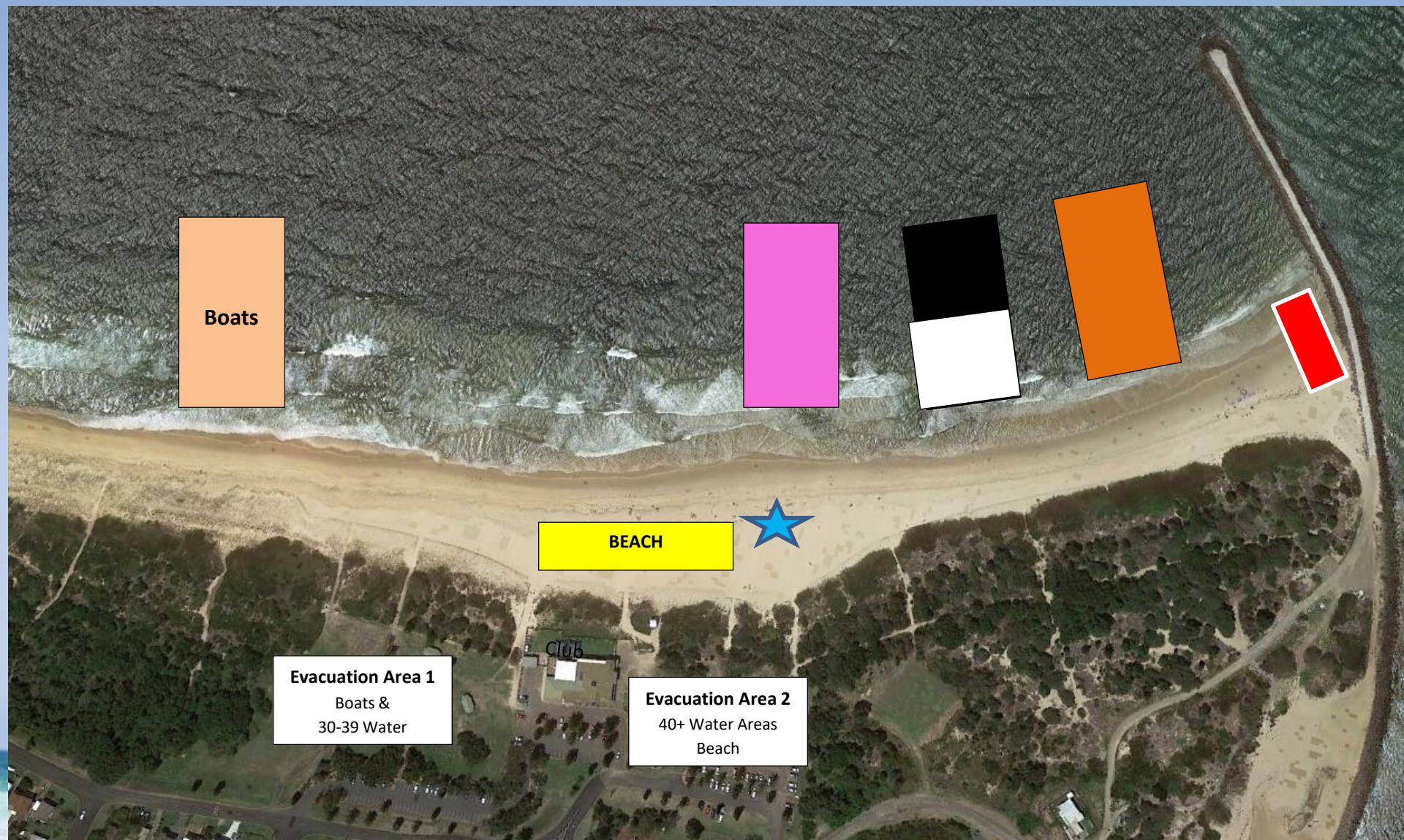
- If any person approaches any official and makes a comment or statement that they are concerned about the beach or surf conditions.
- They will immediately be referred to the Sectional Referee of that arena.
- Details which the complainant will need to provide:
 - Name
 - Club
 - Contact Details
 - Written record of complaint



In Water Emergencies

- During the SLSNSW Open Championships we will have an inshore (SAR) emergency response team.
- In the event of an in water search emergency, no competitor or official is permitted to enter the water, unless they form part of this inshore (SAR) emergency response team.

Marshalling for events:

Wednesday

- Water events: 9.45am report. 10am start
- Beach events: 8.45am report. 9.00am start.

Thursday

- Water events: 7.30am report. 8am start

Friday

- Masters Boats: 9am start.

Important Notes



- Entry to the competition arena will be via the marshalling areas. No member, Coach, or Team Manager will be permitted to enter the competition arena unless escorted by a Competition Official.
- Requirement for all events: ALL COMPETITORS must have their age on their arm e.g. 32.
- It is the competitors responsibility to ensure their position, name and club are recorded correctly.
- There will be security on site however it is recommended that gear is removed from tents.

Warm Up Areas

- No competitor should be within 50m of the water areas whilst the courses are being set by the SLSNSW IRB powercraft team. This is not only a safety issue but it ensures that the courses are correct. Any members/clubs that do not adhere to this may face a disciplinary committee.
- It is recommended that all clubs continue with their risk assessments prior to entering the water for warm up activities.
- For safety of all competitors warming up should commence:

Warm up Wednesday will commence at 9am – 9:40am as follows:

9am – 9:20am Swim warm up only

9:20am – 9:40am Craft warm up only

Warm up Thursday will commence at 7am – 7:40am and as follows:

7am – 7:20am Swim warm up only

7:20am – 7:40am Craft warm up only



Media / Results / Updates / Presentation

- SLSNSW will be posting results, updates and uploading pictures from the event on our Facebook, Twitter accounts and through the event manager entry system.
- SLSNSW will not be issuing any media/photography accreditation to any members. Clubs will be allowed to take photographs from **outside** of the competition area as per normal SLSNSW carnival procedures.

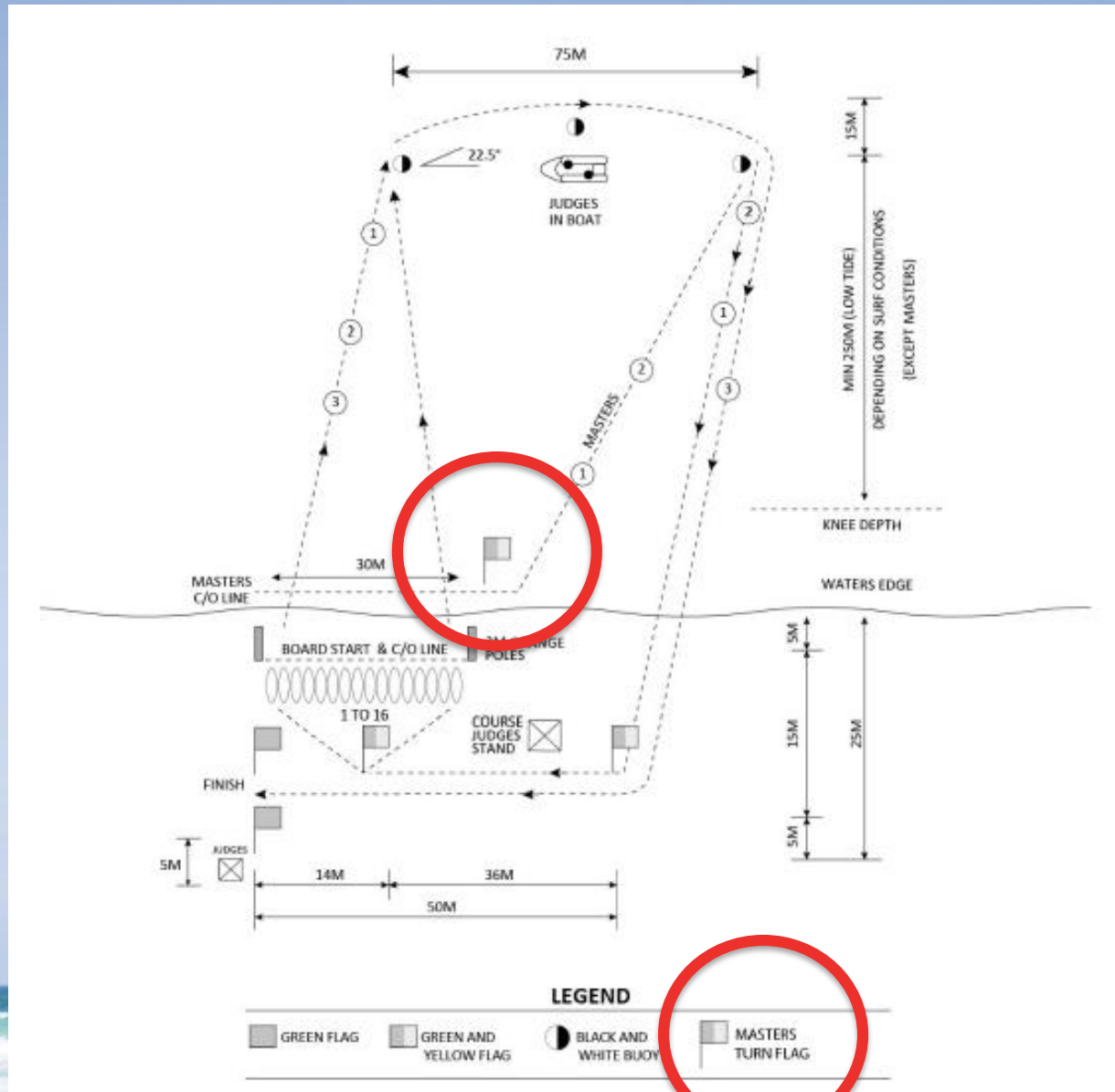
