- Current financial member and hold any relevant awards
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules
- Current Working with Children Check
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of NSW athletes
- All members of Team Management will undertake chaperone responsibilities
- Assist with organising various on the day tasks to support the team and captains
- SLSNSW strongly encourages females to nominate.

How to nominate:

- All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the <u>SLSNSW Selection policy</u> and the <u>SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement</u>. All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- 2. Complete the online nomination form by 11pm Wednesday 7 October 2020.
- 3. All nominations must be endorsed by your club Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.
- 4. SLSNSW intends to contact successful candidates by Friday 9 October.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 7 days after the completion of round 3.

E-Learning:

All successful athletes and team management members will be required to complete both the ASADA Level 1 Anti-Doping and Match Fixing e-learning courses. Both courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLSNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLSNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Portal>Library/Governance/SLSA/Policy 5.1 1 & 5.02). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Alistair Notley anotley@surflifesaving.com.au. SLSNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations.
