## Envirobank Super Team Series

### Round1 – 17 October – Swansea Belmont SLSC

#### Competition Area:

Round 1 of the Envirobank Super Team Series will be made up of 3 areas including 1x Water Area and 1x Beach Area (sprints, flags) and 1 x 2km run track. The proposed event site map is available on page 5 of this document, however, please note the map is not to scale and is subject to change dependant on beach availability and conditions on the day. Competitors are asked to follow instructions given by event staff and the club work crew.

#### Search and Rescue Teams:

In the case of an inshore search and rescue, **team captains** will be required to assist under the direction of the Safety and Emergency Management Coordinator.



### **Warm Up Area:**

Warm-ups are to be conducted outside of the water competition area from 815am. Penalties may apply if it is seen that this is not followed. Each team will be responsible for their own water safety and a risk assessment should be carried out before competitors warm up. Competitors will be required to wear high vis pink vests during warm up and for the duration of the Championship.

### **Contingency Location:**

The contingency location for the carnival will be Caves Beach. Should the contingency location be activated, this will be communicated to Team Captains/Managers via text message and as well as SLSNSW social media/website.

### **Catering:**

Swansea Belmont SLSC will be operating a BBQ for the duration of the event. In addition to this coffee is available for purchase from a number of surrounding cafes within walking distance to Swansea Belmont SLSC and there may be a coffee van onsite. Competitors are encouraged to bring their own food and water.

### **Scrutineering:**

There will be no formal scrutineering of gear and equipment, however **random safety scrutineering** will take place throughout the Championship.

### **Photography & Media:**

#### **Photography:**

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have photos and video taken during the series used for promotional material by SLSNSW. SLSNSW will not be issuing media/photography accreditation to team members or team management. Professional photographers will be attending and material will be available via social media and to Clubs on request. Go Pro's may only be used within the competition area on approved fittings and fixtures as set out in relevant SLSA bulletins.

#### **Media:**

No competitor, team manager, official or spokesperson for a team shall make media statements which could bring the series, its sponsors, or officials into controversy or disrepute. Such statements will be a breach of policy and could potentially result in sanctions against members involved. Please note that statements to the media regarding the event will be made only by approved authorised spokespeople.

#### **Drones:**

For the safety of competitors, officials and spectators SLSNSW prohibits the use of drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) at the event by members and/or public unless approved by SLSNSW, 7 days prior to the event. SLSNSW is intending to utilise the services of Lifesaving UAVs to conduct aerial surveillance and monitor hazards.



### **Behaviour/Misconduct:**

Any misconduct while at the event will not be tolerated. This includes the days leading into competition and any official social activities following the conclusion of the event. Offending members risk disciplinary action against both themselves and their Clubs.

Parents or supporters are not allowed to assist competitors during the competition. Any breach of this policy may result in the disqualification of an athlete from the remainder of the competition and is at the discretion of the Referee.

Please refer to 36<sup>th</sup> Surf Sports Manual sections 2.27 SLSA Code of Behaviour and 2.28 Abuse/Inappropriate Behaviour and the Policy 6.5 – Member Protection Policy (available online at Members Portal > Library > Governance > Policy > SLSA > Policy 6.5).

### **Protests:**

All protests shall be lodged via team captains with the appropriate Liaison Officer in each Area in accordance with the procedures set down in the current edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins, and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Competition Manual and or event rules upon which the protest is based.

### **Event Conditions:**

The general competitive conditions as detailed in the current edition of the SSM and any subsequent Bulletins shall apply to the conduct of these events except where amended by the series rules.

All events where possible and, conditions permitting, shall be conducted as finals. Excluding the Beach sprint which will have 2 Heats followed by an A & B final.

### **The primary amendments are:**

#### **a) Water Courses:**

With the exception of the Board Rescue events all individual and team water events will be conducted around the buoy courses, and distances, set for the individual legs of the Ironperson event (as per the current edition of the SSM) e.g. All Surf Races/Teams will be conducted only around the string of nine set at a minimum distance of 120 metres.

The Board Rescue events shall be conducted as per the standard courses outlined in the current edition of the SSM.

#### **b) Water Event Starts:**

Unless otherwise advised, all water events, with the exception of the Surf Ski events (water start) shall be started on the beach approximately 15 metres from the water's edge (run start).

**c) Water Event Finishes:**

Unless otherwise advised, all water events shall finish as per the Ironperson races (run finish). Craft and paddles may be abandoned after rounding the last turning buoy of the swim course. Handlers are to be used to remove craft and paddles from the course.

**d) Change Over Area and Tagging for Relay Style Events:**

In all relay style events (except the Board Rescue Relay) the Carnival Referee will designate a Changeover Area. In the Changeover Area a tag must take place between the incoming competitor and the outgoing competitor. The tag can take place on any part of the body. Any breach of the Changeover Rule may result in disqualification.

**Point Score:**

Placings in finals will be allocated points on an 12,11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, basis for the positions 1<sup>st</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>, for each event contested. For events with only 6 Individuals or 6 teams, points will be allocated on a 6,5,4,3,2,1 basis for positions 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>.

At the end of each round points will be assigned to each team 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>. 6,5,4,3,2,1. These will accumulate and carry across to the final round. At the conclusion of Round 3 the team with the highest total will be declared the winners. (Maximum total points = 18)

**Dead Heats**

Dead heats in both team and individual events shall be declared as per current Edition of the SSM. Placings shall be awarded as follows: Equal first will result in no second place being awarded with the next placed competitor or team being awarded third place etc. In the event of a three-way dead heat for first the next placed competitor or team shall be awarded fourth place and so on.
