Subject: Junior Activity and Training Delivery – Lord Howe Island

In October 2018 Lord Howe Island and SLSNSW co-signed a relationship deed, creating a new Community Nipper Club. This club is one of two community Nipper clubs in NSW, offering endorsed Nipper activities to children aged between 5-13. The club is recognised by SLSNSW to conduct a Nippers program in Lord Howe Island and is affiliated to SLSNSW.

We are calling for expressions of interest from a suitable qualified member to delivery Junior Activity Age Manager Training, proficiency skills update as well as SRC and/or Bronze Medallion training for members based on Lord Howe Island.

The successful applicant will work closely with the SLSNSW Membership Team and the Lord Howe Island Community Nippers Club to ensure that the delivery of training meets the needs of the members and the SLSNSW requirements.

Role and Responsibility

This member will be responsible for:

- Preparing a training plan to meet the needs of the club members (including both online and face to face delivery)
- Delivery of training and assessment for Age Managers Course, SRC and possibly a Bronze Medallion Course
- Coordination of training resources required
- SurfGuard processes related to training delivered

Please note that the successful applicant will not be required to undertake quarantine. They must ensure that they have not visited a COVID-19 hotspot within 72 hours of their departure. Time Commitment

The member be required to travel from Port Macquarie to Lord Howe Island for a period of one week (either 6-13 November OR 13-20 November). There will be a time requirement to plan the delivery of training, including the possibility of online training prior to departure.
