The <u>NSW Women's Week Grants</u> opened on 11/1/21 and close 4pm AEST on 25/1/21. These grants seek to celebrate the efforts and contributions of women during NSW Women's Week (8-14 March 2021).

- Grants of \$3,000 to \$5,000 are available to local government and not-for-profit organisations to support activities or events in line with one or more of the priorities of the NSW Women's Strategy:
 - Economic opportunity and advancement
 - Health and wellbeing, e.g. events that celebrate, promote, and support a holistic approach to women's health
 - o Participation and empowerment
- Projects/events MUST take place during NSW Women's Week 2021 (8-14 March 2021) and MUST comply with all relevant COVID-19 requirements and restrictions in place at the time of the event/activity.
- Attachments include public liability statement; and quotes/budget.
- Ineligible items include staff wages (except for temporary instructors/facilitators for your event or activity); equipment/building; and commercial activities.
