We will welcome all competitors and provide an update on events based on numbers and water conditions (a risk assessment will take place prior to this time)

Covid Safety Requirements

Entries

Enter online here before Friday 12th February.

Due to maximum attendance restrictions at the State Age Championships, clubs are required to only enter members that intend to race. This approach will enable SLSNSW to plan and manage the event safety in line with COVID-19 safety requirements.

SLSNSW may request clubs to selfselect a smaller team if maximum event numbers are exceeded (40 members only) and we will be managing these numbers in the coming weeks.

Note that no entries will be accepted on the day of the event.

Events:

The events that will be running are Beach Sprints, Beach Flags, Wade, Swim, Board.

Events will be run for male and female, and competitors split into junior and senior events.

This year there will be no March Past or Relays due to COVID-19.

Bio Zones:

The State Age Championships has been split into 4 bio-zones (event bubbles) to manage COVD-19 safety requirements and maximum event numbers. Each bio-zone will be at a different time and/or location.

Competitors, families, and officials will only be permitted to attend 1 bio-zone during the 2021 NSW Surf Life Saving Championships i.e., attendees are permitted to attend 1 location for one of the 2-day time blocks only. Inclusive events will fit into the following bio-zone:

U12, U13 & U14 Water Championships:

Saturday 27th – Sunday 28th February at Swansea Belmont SLSC

Please keep this in mind when considering your entry nomination or your attendance at this event. This is especially important if you have children in other bio-zones or are needed for water safety or team manager duties.

Further information will be released closer to the date on the following COVID requirements:

- Spectator restrictions spectators are included in the maximum number of attendees so we will be limiting the number of spectators per participant. Details to come.
- Mandatory pre-registration of attendance for all attendees that have not been entered in competitor/ official nominations
- QR code check in and wristband process for each bio-zone access.
- One-way beach entry and exits.

Some other helpful points...

- Parking there is a drop off zone near the club, parking is in surrounding streets.
- Change rooms shown on the map, let us know if you need an accessible space.
- **Photos** feel free to take photos of your child competing in these events.
- Merchandise there is a merchandise tent beside the surf club and an online store prior to the event where you can purchase event items such as shirts and hats.
- Water Events bring your pink vest (if you have one) and board if you are planning to participate. Competitors can choose how they participate in the water e.g. a wade, swim or a splash around the cans depending on the conditions on the day.
- Medals each competitor will receive a State Championship medal for competing on the day. Event placings will also be presented with a medal.
- Bring your water safety support crew (wearing their orange rashie, cap and rescue tube) if you are planning on joining us in the water. Any other support that you require on the day (ear defenders, sand shoes, glasses and hats) please make sure you bring them along with you.
