Bio-Zone Questions



Why do you have to choose only 1 age bio-zone to attend?

What happens to parents who have children across more than one bio-zone?

Can competitors do beach and water to make up a team – especially the smaller clubs?

What about coaches who coach competitors across more than one bio-zone?

What about provision of official's and water safety across bio-zones?

Why can't Masters compete in Open events?

If I produce a negative COVID test, why can't I cross bio-zones?

Event Check-in



- The NSW Government strongly advises events to use the Service NSW App to check-in <https://youtu.be/s-uhdUfWXMo>
- ALL ATTENDEES are required to check in each day of competition
- Please promote this to all members to ensure that they have the app and know how to use it
- Remind members to bring their mobile to the event.

Ticketing



- Attendance must not exceed 3,000 at each bio-zone
- Tickets will be allocated to all spectators (for bio-zones 2,4 & 5)
- No ticket = no entry
- Club allocation: 1 ticket per competitor and 50% of total for club distribution e.g. 10 competitors = 15 tickets (based on bio-zone entries)

Wrist Bands



- Anyone within the competition area requires an event issued wrist band for each day
- Wrist bands will change in colour and cannot be used across bio-zones
- Wrist bands are essential to access the event. No wrist band, you will be asked to leave the area
- Police have been briefed and will be patrolling our competition areas

Do I need a wrist band each day??

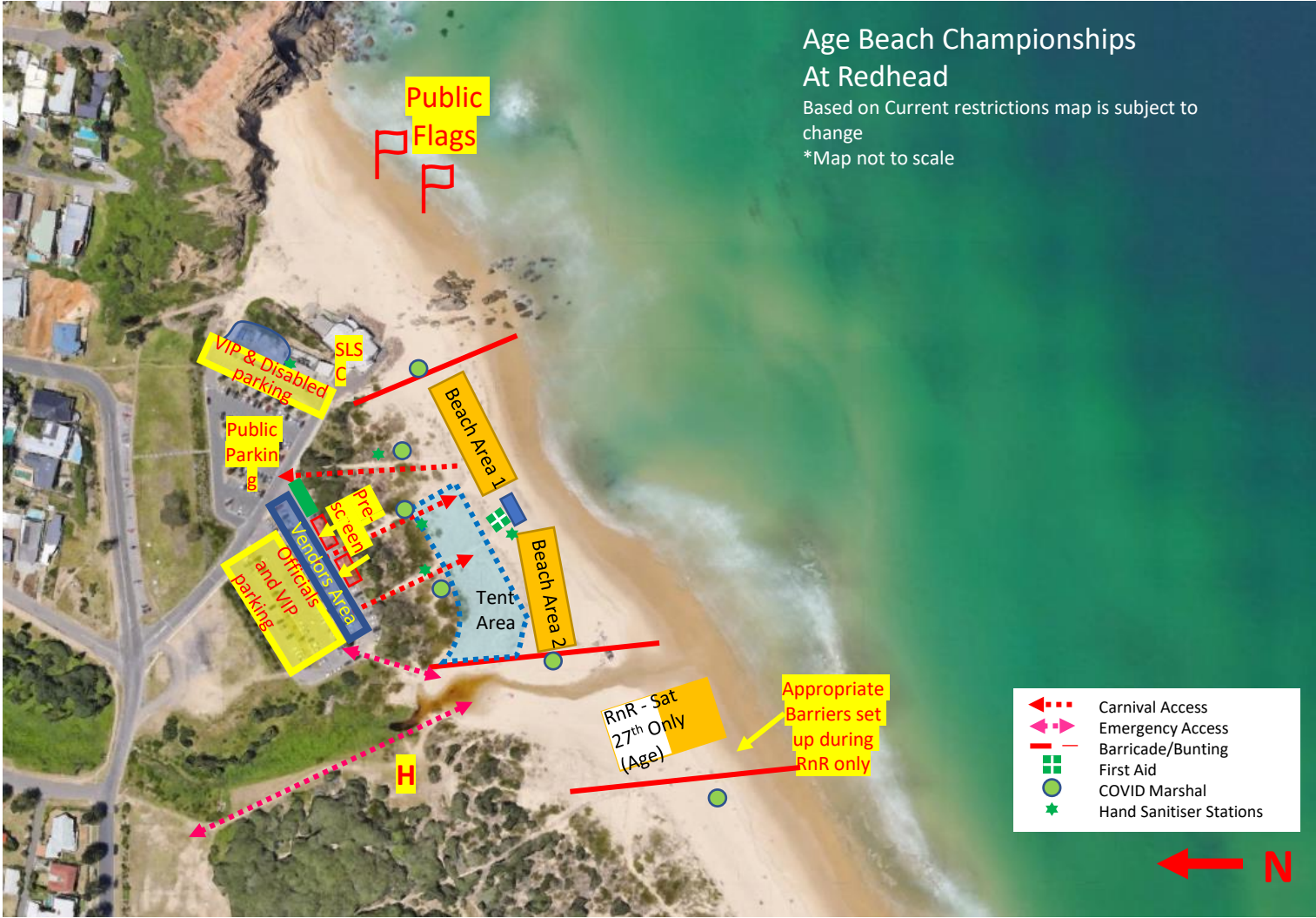
Pre-Screening

- Rash vest Collection

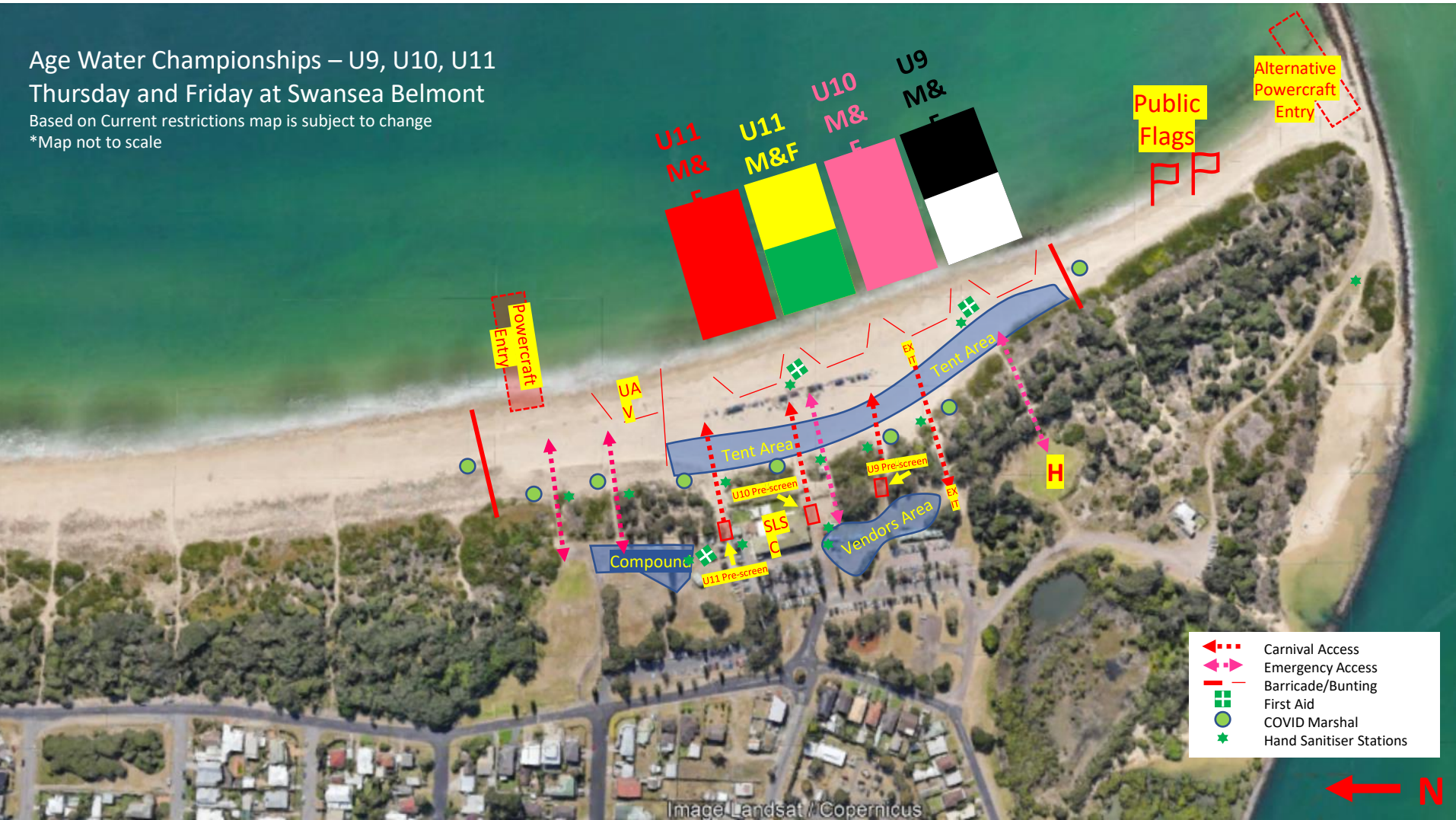
Age Beach Championships At Redhead

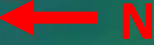


Age Water Championships – U9, U10, U11 Thursday and Friday at Swansea Belmont

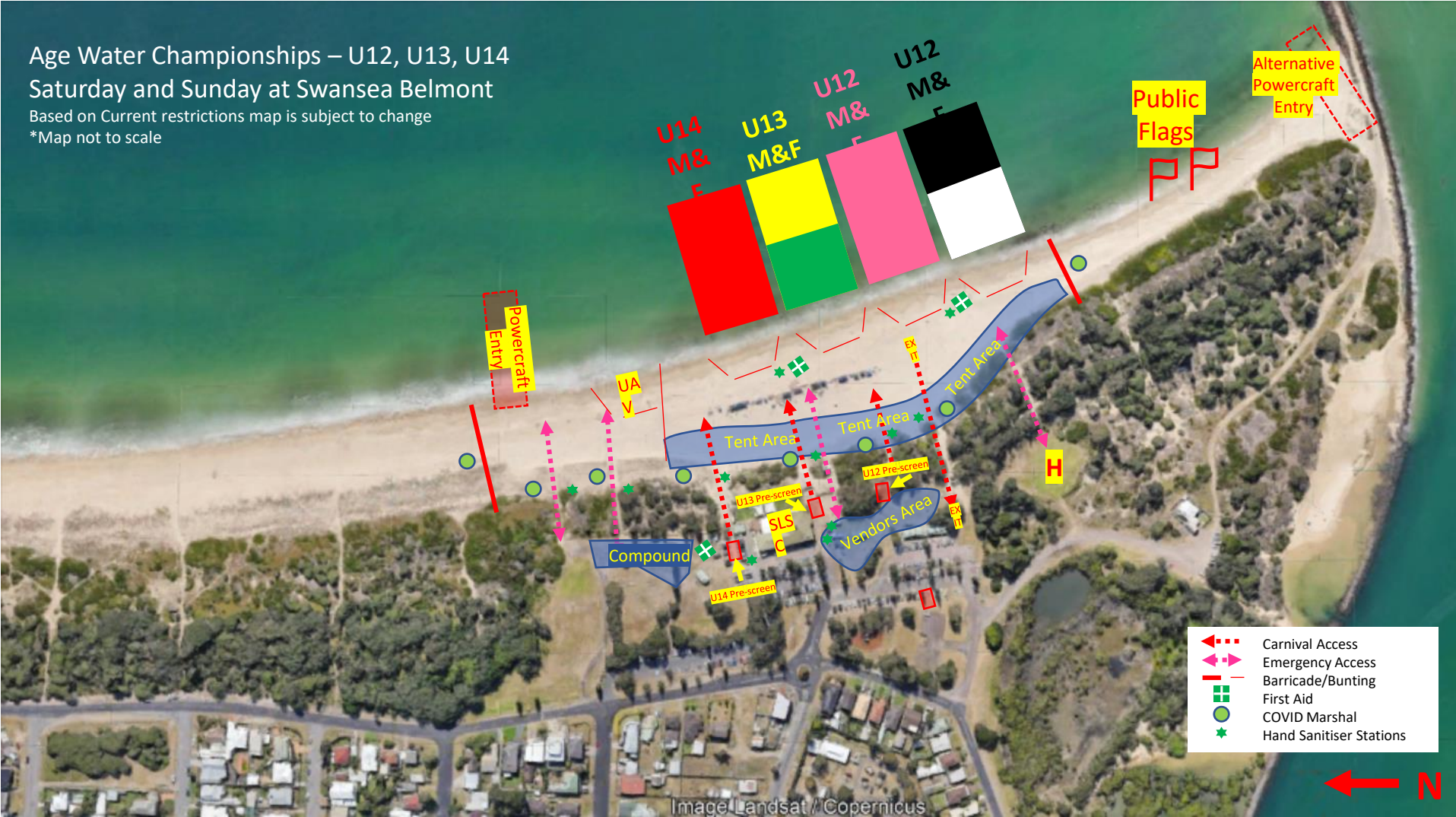


Age Water Championships – U12, U13, U14
