SLSA in conjunction with the ASRL are calling for **all** Surf Sports Officials wishing to participate at the 2019 ASRL Open, which will be held at Elouera Beach, NSW. The event will be held from Friday February 15th – Sunday February 17th 2019.

NOMINATIONS CLOSE FRIDAY JANUARY 18TH 2019

The appointment of all Officials will be made by the ASRL. Officials will be finalised as soon as possible after the close of nomination and all appointments will be posted on the on the <u>ASRL</u> <u>webpage</u>. Late nominating Officials will be added to the 'Officials Pool' and duties and appointments made be subject to the availability of roles.

All officials should ensure they are physically capable to carry out the requirements of their specific role over the course of the Championships, and are encouraged to undertake a medical check prior to departure to the Championships.

NOTE: All appointed officials will be required to officiate the full three days.

NOTE: All appointed officials will be required to attend the pre-event **OFFICIALS BRIEFING** as well as a briefing in their appointed competition areas, prior to competition.
