Summary:	This circular outlines the application for the Area and Sectional Referee positions of the Australian Youth, Masters and Opens Surf Life Saving Championships.

Positions

SLSA is now calling for official nominations of all age groups regarding the **Australian Surf Life Saving Championships (Youth, Masters and Opens)** for the following positions:

- Area Referees, including Scrutineering Referee and Powercraft Referee
- Sectional Referees, including Powercraft Base Coordinator and Lifesaving Sectional Referees

Appointments will be for a period of 2 years but may be subject to change depending on changes to other senior appointments over the 2 year period.

Dates and locations

- 2019: March 30th – April 7th at Broadbeach and North Burleigh Beach, Queensland
Youth Championships: March 30th - 31st North Burleigh
Masters Championships: April 1st – 2nd Broadbeach
Open Championships: April 3rd – 7th Broadbeach
- 2020: March/April (dates TBC) at Broadbeach and North Burleigh Beach, Queensland

Selection panel

Applicants must be members with the current appropriate official qualification (Level 2 or 3 – Senior Official) and experience.

All appointments will be made jointly decided by the following:

- SLSA Chair, Sport
- SLSA Sport Manager
- SLSA Officials Advisor
- Australian Championships Masters and Opens Referee
- Australian Championships Youth Referee

Application process

- 1) Email a copy of the completed application form below (following page);
- 2) Attach a cover letter to the email that addresses the relevant selection criteria found in the position description and the below experience (maximum 2 pages):
 - Accreditation Level
 - Years of Officiating
 - Detail Club/Branch/State level officiating experience
 - Detail National level officiating experience

An interview may occur with the shortlisted applicants shortly after nominations close and the successful candidate will be finalised as soon as possible after selection. To apply, please ensure you complete the following:
