How to Nominate:

- 1. All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW <u>Selection</u> <u>Policy</u> and the SLSNSW <u>Athlete & Management Agreement</u>. All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- 2. Complete the online form here by 11pm Thursday 1st July 2021.
- 3. All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire <u>letters of endorsement</u>. Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

Team Levy:

All costs including travel and accommodation for the Interstate Championships in Queensland are the responsibility of individuals, as many will be competing for their respective clubs also.

Training Sessions:

It is anticipated that successful applicants will be notified shortly after the 2021 SLSNSW Pool Rescue Championships. Following selection, a training session will be conducted prior to the Interstate Championships with more information to follow.
