Dear all accredited Surf Coaches,

As you are aware, the new discipline specific SLSA Coaching Framework has taken over what was formerly known as the Junior Coaching, Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 courses. All coaches were transferred over to this new framework in December 2018.

You are receiving this memorandum as your coaching accreditation (Foundation or Development) expires December 31 2019.

Please note all reaccreditations must be endorsed by a club officer and signed off by an accredited assessor for each discipline you are reaccrediting in. It is also a prerequisite to hold the ASADA Anti-Doping level 1 and ASC Community Coaching General Principles awards [external]. Both awards are free of charge and do not expire, if you have already completed these courses, you will not need to do so again.

You can check your current awards by logging in to the SLSA Members Area.

The following steps have been outlined to simplify the reaccreditation process:

1. Complete the [reaccreditation form](#)
2. Have a Club Officer endorse your reaccreditation
3. Tick all disciplines you wish to be reaccredited in up the top of the form
4. Contact an [SLSNSW accredited coaching assessor](#) to sign off your paperwork, an assessment of your practical coaching and training programs is required
5. Ensure you have completed the [ASADA](#) and [ASC](#) [external] courses
6. Return your completed paperwork via the online [Coaching Re-accreditation Submission Portal](#) **before 31 December 2019.**

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
