All competitors entered into the 2020 NSW Country and State Championships will be issued an official high visibility pink competition lycra vest. It is a requirement for all competitors to wear the supplied Lycra vest in competition at the 2020 NSW Country and State Championships. See SSM (12.1, d, xviii). Clubs must ensure that competitors wear the approved lycra vest in competition, no other branded vests may be worn. Competitors may be requested to wear the approved lycra vest as part of medal presentations.

Please do not order more than realistically required for the number of competitors that your club has entered in each event. SLSNSW will verify the order against the actual number of entries received and Clubs may be liable for the cost of excessive orders.

If you complete this form and need to update the information, please just complete the form again with the new total lycra vests required. SLSNSW will use the most recently completed order form in the system.

If your Club has not submitted an order by the closing date, you will be allocated a default number and sizing of lycra vests.

Before you start the order form, you will need;

- 1. Estimated number of athletes and their sizes
- 2. Authorisation from your Club. It is highly recommended that Clubs communicate internally and submit the form once per Championships. I.e.; SLSNSW is aware that some larger Clubs handle their administration in different ways; however we require a single club total (per Championship).

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will we get the exact order of Lycra vests placed?

Best endeavors will be made to provide each Club with the quantity and sizing ordered, however this cannot be guaranteed and will be allocated based on availability. Please see below the sizing chart:

Can I wear a different competition singlet/Lycra vest?

No. All competitors entered into the 2020 NSW Country and State Championships will be issued an official high visibility pink competition lycra vest. Clubs must ensure that competitors wear the approved lycra vest in competition, no other branded vests may be worn. Competitors may be requested to wear the approved lycra vest as part of medal presentations.

When do I receive a Lycra vest?

Lycra vests will be available for collection at the event by team managers. Further details, will be provided closer to the event.

What if my Club does not submit an order by the closing date?

If your Club does not submit an order, you will be allocated a default number and sizing of lycra vests.

What if I am doing a late entry, will I still get a lycra vest?

Yes – if the late entry is completed before the close of online late entries. There are no late entries accepted at the Championships as per 2019.

My club ordered the wrong size for me can I swap the Lycra vest?

While it is difficult to ensure all competitors are issued with a perfect fit lycra vest within your club you will have enough to swap among competitors. SLSNSW will also have a limited supply of spares at the Championships to exchange.

Previously in team water events at large carnivals every junior water based competitor in team events was required to wear a hi-visibility pink numbered (1, 2, 3 etc.) singlet, what is the requirement now?

This no longer required for the 2020 events.
