Title:	Surf Sport: Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2020– Call for Official nominations

Summary:	Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) is calling for applications for all Technical Officials, Support Services Officials and Lifesaving Officials nominations for the Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2020.

Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) is calling for nominations from ALL Surf Sport Officials, as well as all Medical Personnel wishing to participate at the 2020 Australian Youth Championships, Australian Masters Championships and the Australian Open Championships to be held across the North Burleigh, Broadbeach and Burleigh beaches from Saturday 18 April to Sunday 26 April 2020.

For Aussies 2020, SLSA are calling for official to nominate for the Championships. Further call may be made if roles are not filled for the Australian Championships. The roles include all technical roles, support services roles and lifesaving roles.

NOMINATIONS CLOSE: FRIDAY 29 NOVEMBER 2019

As the events will be conducted over a number of areas, SLSA is looking for officials to fill positions in each of the areas. Nominations should include details of preferred roles you wish to fulfil at the event, with three (3) preferences for each Championship listed in priority order.

If you have nominated for a Senior Officials positions at either of the three (3) Championships (as per Circular 20/19-20), please ensure you nominate for a Technical Officials position should you be unsuccessful in gaining the Senior role.

The appointment of all Officials will be made jointly by the Championship Referee and the National Officials Advisor. Officials will be finalised as soon as possible after the close of nominations and all appointments will be posted on the SLSA Members Area and SLSA website. Late nominating officials will be added to the 'Officials Pool' and duties and appointments made subject to availability of roles.

All officials should ensure they are physically capable to carry out their important functions over the course of the Championships and are encouraged to undertake a medical check prior to departure to the event.

NOTE: With the introduction of further technology, some of the traditional Recording roles may be changed, however, if required, training will be provided.

NOTE: All appointed officials will be required to complete the online Officials Briefing, attend the face-to-face briefing at The Championships and also the briefing in their appointed competition areas, prior to competition. All times and locations will be outlined in the Officials Appointments circular. The Championships safety procedures and contingency plans will be communicated via these briefings. Therefore, the Officials briefings are mandatory and failure to complete and/or attend may result in your appointment being terminated and/or referred to the Australian Surf Life Saving Championships Competition Committee for further action.
