Surf Life Saving NSW is looking for additional candidates for it's upcoming Lifesaving Development Camp, July 2022. This is a live-in program, for surf lifesavers aged 16-21 years, focusing on developing and enhancing the knowledge and skills of young people, while at the same time preparing them to take on more responsibility in their patrol teams, their own clubs, and the wider community. Members will gain additional awards including First Aid, ARTC, IRB Crew/Drivers, and expand their current knowledge of awards already held.

Want to know more?

The camp outcomes are achieved by providing the young people who attend the Lifesaving Development Camp with a higher level of award training, and exposure to exciting, fast-paced simulated lifesaving scenarios. Camp attendees will use the standard patrolling equipment to manage 'no-notice' scenarios that become more complex as their skills develop.
