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Summary	SLSNSW is calling for nominations from accredited coaches wishing to be appointed as an Assistant Coach for one of five NSW teams competing in the 2022 Super Surf Teams League

INTRODUCTION

SLSNSW will be entering five teams into the 2022 Super Surf Teams League (SSTL). Athletes will be selected via a live draft to ensure teams are of similar experience and ability.

SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Coach roles to lead the five NSW based teams in the 2022 Super Surf Teams League. These positions will be supported by NSW Head Coach Jimmy Walker.

SCHEDULE

The SSTL will be held across three rounds from 14-16 January, 2022 at North Bondi.

ASSISTANT COACH ROLE

The roles available for the Super Surf Team League are:

- Assistant Coach (x5) – will expire 28 days after the last round of the 2022 Super Surf Teams League.

Requirements of Assistant Coach:

- All nominees must be current financial members
- Current SLSA Development Coach Accreditation
- Willing to undertake a Working with Children Check (WWCC)
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules

- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Highly motivated and passionate in enhancing the success of NSW athletes
- Lead Coach will also undertake chaperone responsibilities
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing last round
- Assist with organising various training sessions team within the appointment period
- Report to NSW Surf Interstate Lead Coach (may also be a SSTL Coach)
- Assistant Coaches will be responsible for team configuration and coordinating athletes on the day of competition and Round to Round in consultation with the Lead Coach
- Assistant Coaches for all 5 teams shall work together on logistics for athletes and function as a wider NSW group.

COST

All (if any) travel and all accommodation costs are the responsibility of the individual including making arrangements.

SLNSW have decided that any subsidy will be allocated across the Coaching group to reflect the amount of travel different coaches will be required to undertake (i.e. Country based coaches may be in receipt of a greater subsidy to reflect the greater travel requirements).

We do however require coaches nominating to do so understanding they will be responsible for the majority of their travel costs.

How to Nominate:

1. All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in Selection Policy and Athlete & Management Agreement.

3. It is anticipated that Coaches will be notified of their appointment by Friday 10 December 2021

E-Learning:

All successful athletes and team management members will be required to complete both the ASADA Level 1 and Level 2 Anti-Doping and also Match Fixing e-learning courses. These courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. Moving forward, SLNSW strongly believe this is a great additive to the structure of any touring team and/or squad and is vital for elite competition and athlete development.

SLNSW fully supports the new SLSA Anti-Doping and Match Fixing policies (SLSA Members Area). Following the completion of each course, a completion certificate/email must be forwarded to Surfsports@surflifesaving.com.au SLNSW have organised with SLSA to have these courses uploaded on to SurfGuard as an award. Once completed, the courses do not have to be completed again, unless there is an update in information from the organisations.

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
