<b>Title:</b> Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2022 – Lifesaving Officials Appointments (V1 – February 2022)

<b>Summary:</b> This circular contains the names of the Officials appointed for the 2022 Lifesaving Australian Surf Life Saving Championships, together with all relevant reporting, briefing and other matters for notation by appointed Officials.

This document has been prepared with the best intentions based on current State Health Authority information regarding COVID-19 restrictions and related border movements. However, as has been noted over many months this information is constantly changing and as such all officials should be prepared to allow for some flexibility in their planning. SLSA will do their best to provide advance notice on the listed options and possible further amendments however, again, as has been witnessed over many months COVID-19 restrictions can be amended with little to no notice by the various State Health Authorities.

SLSA has been actively working with QLD Health and the Gold Coast City Council and has finalised the COVID Safe Plan for the Championships. Due to the dynamic nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, and related restrictions, SLSA cannot guarantee there will be no amendments to the event and/or the timetable of races leading into and during the Championships. All endeavors are being examined and discussed to keep the event as normal as possible however SLSA acknowledges that due to the COVID-19 pandemic there are likely to be restrictions in some form placed on the Championships.

If Officials are unavailable to attend these Championships or believe that there is a conflict of interest concerning their appointment, please contact the Events Team on the details shown below.

### NOTE 2:

Any Officials not appointed to these Championships will be placed into the Officials Pool and may be called upon to fulfil a role in the case of a withdrawal of an Official.

### NOTE 3:

Any Officials who believe they have submitted a nomination form and do not appear on the appointment list, please contact the Events Team to check your nomination. Please note, those Officials that have nominated after the first closing date will appear in V2 of the appointments.

### NOTE 4:

Aussies 2022 will see the introduction of Live Heats. The Live Heats system will coordinate the marshalling and recording of most contests. It will run parallel to Officials carrying out their roles, however those roles including Recorders and Computer Operators will change slightly. Guidance, support and an online training session will be provided to relevant Officials prior to the event.
