- Any members missing selection for the 2022 NSW IRB Team will be considered for the 2022 NSW IRB Development Team.

Team Levy

Uniform

Selected team members will be supplied a team uniform. Due to the tight turnaround between selection and competition, athletes may not receive specific sizes requested.

Training Sessions

All nominees are required to attend any Team Selection Training Sessions that may be scheduled (*details to be confirmed by the Lead Coach, should any training sessions be scheduled*).

It is anticipated that successful applicants will be notified following the conclusion of the 2022 NSW Sharkskin IRB Championships at South West Rocks SLSC on **Sunday 10 July 2022**.

SLSA Anti-Doping Policy

Surf Life Saving Australia supports the Australian Government, SportAus, the AOC, and the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) in their efforts to eradicate the use of drugs in sport. SLSA has published an Anti-doping Policy, which will be adhered to for this event.

Please be aware that random drug testing by ASADA could take place during the competition. It is highly recommended each State/Territory team member (including management and staff) complete the ASADA online e-learning program (Level 1) to ensure all personnel are aware of contemporary issues pertaining to anti-doping.
